

Previously, in pt. 3 – nope they didn't survive the **MACC** attack. 






Also he remembered the injury of the children of Baean (an Idumaen chief) who had been a snare and a stumbling block unto the people, in that they lay in wait for them in the ways.

Gilead

Also known as Galaad

- In the bible Gilead is an idyllic section of the land of the Hebrews, a mountainous region east of Jordan.
- In Hebrew the name means "heap of stones"
- MA probably referring to Jeremiah 8:22;
 "Is there no balm in Gilead; is there no physician there? Why then is not the health of the daughter of my people recovered?"
- One Old Testament reference which Gilead chooses not to include occurs in Hosea 6:8 'Gilead is a city of wicked men, with footprints of blood.' (Look for omissions and misinterpretations throughout the text)



"Come now therefore and deliver us from their hands, for many of us are slain. Yea, all our brothers who were in the places of Tobie, are put to death: their wives and their children also they have carried away captives, and borne away their stuff, and they have destroyed there about a thousand men."



While these letters were yet being read, behold, there came other messengers from Galilee, with their clothes rent, who reported according to these words, and said, "They of Ptolemais, and of Tyrus, and Sidon, and all Galilee of the Gentiles, are assembled together against us to consume us."








Then said Judas to Simon his brother, choose your men, and go and deliver your brothers who are in Galilee; but I and Jonathan will go into the country of Galaad. So he left Joseph the son of Zacharias and Azarias, captains of the people, with the remnant of the host in Judaea, to keep it.

* The tribe of Levi, as the priesthood, were distributed throughout the other tribes.






And he pursued them to the gate of Ptolemais; and there were slain of the heathen about three thousand men, whose spoils he took.





Galilee of the Gentiles






JERUSALEM SKY With TRUMPET SOUNDS





This done, Judas turned aside to



So they went up to mount Zion with joy and gladness, where they offered burnt offerings, because not one of them was slain until they had returned in peace. 3/10/2018








