



The only way that the bottom of the crescent moon can be illuminated, is by the sun being well below the moon.

Isaiah 11:11






Daniel 7:2-3

Hmm, the FE's think this proves their Flat Earth, when it's a VISION!!!




Daniel 11:3-4

Debunking the FE's:

The four winds are also the four quadrants of the earth, which are the directions of the compass and frankly the same as the four corners of the earth. The winds that come up from the North, South, East and West or between quadrants.





1st Chronicles 16:30

"Fear before him, all the earth: the world also shall be stable, that it not be moved."

The Hebrew word "stable/established" (Tikkown – root word Kun -Strong's H3559) is used in many of the verses the FE's use as their flat earth proof and it means: arranged, set up, secure, stable, steadfast, furnished, firm, fashioned, ordained, prepared or made for something. It does NOT mean something is locked down.



Here are some examples contradicting the FE's:

"The day is yours, the night is also yours; you have prepared/established (H3559) the light and the sun. (Psalm 74:16

"It shall be *established* (H3559) for ever as the moon, and as a faithful witness in heaven. Selah" (Psalm 89:37)

What FE is going to dare say the sun and the moon are established and cannot be moved? In their FE model, the sun and moon move in rotation (spin) over the earth. Therefore if they want to say H3559 means the earth can't move, then their sun and moon cannot move either.

Taking a look at the Hebrew word for "moved" which is "timote" from the root word "mote" H4131. The word means the earth WILL NOT teeter, slip, fall, falter, be brought down, deviate, be overthrown, be out of course, be carried away, or be shaken out of course.


Therefore the earth can rotate and spin, but will not deviate on its own way from the way Yahuah designed it to operate which totally fits the definition of the Hebrew words for established (Tikkown from Kun) and for the word moved (Timote from Mote). Cast your burden to Yahuah, and he will sustain you. He will never allow the righteous to be *moved* (H4131)


If the same words and phrases are used for the righteous that are used for the earth, then FE's are obligated to apply their same interpretation to the righteous as they do to the earth. Therefore according to the FE's interpretation, the righteous are fixed and immovable. The righteous are unable to turn and move like they claim that the earth cannot turn or rotate.



FE's use the following Scriptures to prove the earth has literal pillars holding it up using 1Samuel 2:8, Job 9:6 and as their proof, but as usual they aren't looking at all of the other Scriptures around the verses!

1st Samuel 2:8 is showing that Yahuah can take a beggar and turn him into a prince. The world is NOT the planet but the people. Here's the full context! 1Samuel 2:7-10

Yahuah makes poor, and makes rich; He brings low, and lifts up. He raises the poor out of the dust, and lifts up the beggar from the dunghill to set among princes, and to make them inherit the throne of glory: for the pillars of the earth are Yahuah's and he has set the world up on them. He will keep the feet of the saints, and the wicked shall be silent in darkness; for by strength shall no man prevail. The adversaries of Yahuah shall be broken into pieces; out of heaven, shall He thunder upon them; Yahuah shall judge the ends of the earth; and He




Job 9:5-6

"He is the one who moves mountains, and they do not know how, who overturns them in anger. He is the one who shakes the earth from its place, and its pillars tremble.

Do the mountains have awareness? Is Job 9:5 implying that Yahuah caught the mountains by surprise and flipped them over without them knowing what happened? If you take this passage literally, then you're conclusion has to be that mountains have human-like awareness! 



This Psalm talks about the earth (dry land) and the people on the earth melting or dissolving away. Obviously this is figurative language unless the FE's want to believe that people are literally melting and dissolving away. The mention of the pillars should be taken that even if the world appears to be melting, dissolving or falling apart, Yahuah is keeping everything together to prevent a total collapse of society.



Flat Earther's Claim: The Earth is Covered By A Dome

Genesis 1:6-8 - And God said, Let there be <u>a firmament</u> in the midst of the waters, and let it divide the waters from the waters. And God made the firmament, and divided the waters which were under the firmament from the waters which were above the firmament: and it was so. And God called the firmament Heaven. And the evening and the morning were the second day. God called the firmament the sky/heaven/space. He didn't call it the dome of the sky or dome of the earth.

Genesis 1:14-19- And God said, Let there be lights in the firmament of the heaven to divide the day from the night; and let them be for signs, and for seasons, and for days, and years: And let them be for lights in the firmament of the heaven to give light upon the earth: and it was so. And God made two great lights; the greater light to rule the day, and the lesser light to rule the night: he made the stars also. And God set them in the firmament of the heaven to give light upon the earth, And to rule over the day and over the night, and to divide the light from the darkness: and God saw that it was good. And the evening and the morning were the fourth day. NOTE: In the flat earth model, flat-earthers place the sun and moon under their firmament and NOT in the firmament like they do with the stars. Their model does not match the biblical creation account. The sun, magangages all have to be in the same location (in the firmament). So the sun and moon can't be freely floating over the earth while the stars are stuck in the walls of their firmament.



Job 9:8 - Which alone spreadeth out the heavens, and treadeth upon the waves of the sea. Heaven is an expanse not a dome!

Job 26:7 - He stretcheth out the north over the empty place, and hangeth the earth upon nothing. Heaven is an expanse not a dome!

Job 28:24 - For he looketh to the ends of the earth, and <u>seeth under the whole heaven</u>; God can see everthing but that fact does not prove the earth is flat.

Job 37:18 - Hast thou with him spread out the sky, which is strong, and as a molten looking glass? Note: The word for sky used in this verse is the Hebrew word for clouds and it means powder and vapor, so it would be hard to claim powder and vapor represents a solid dome. The word for strong also means mighty and loud. Notice it says "as a" and not "is a" molten looking glass or metal mirror. This is a simile and it does not speak about a dome. This verse is talking about a hot desert storm with thick clouds, dust, and loud thunder.



Ezekiel 10:1 -Then I looked, and, behold, in <u>the firmament</u> that was above the head of the cherubims there appeared over them as it were a sapphire stone, as the appearance of the likeness of a throne. See Our note below.

Daniel 12:3 -And they that be wise shall shine as the brightness of <u>the firmament</u>; and they that turn many to righteousness as the stars for ever and ever. This is only describing the firmament (the sky) as being bright, which it is during the day. This does not prove a dome.


Amos 9:6 -It is he that buildeth his stories in the heaven, and hath <u>founded his troop</u> in the earth; he that calleth for the waters of the sea, and poureth them out upon the face of the earth: The LORD is his name. See our note below.

Jeremiah 10:12 - He hath made the earth by his power, he hath established the world by his wisdom, and hath <u>stretched out the heavens</u> by his discretion. **Agree it's an expanse - Not a dome!**

Jeremiah 51:15 - He hath made the earth by his power, he hath established the world by his wisdom, and hath <u>stretched out the heaven</u> by his understanding. **Agree it's an expanse - Not a dome!**

DEBUNKED: In many English versions of the Bible, the word "firmament" is used as a translation for the Hebrew word "raqia" Strong's H7549, which is found In Genesis 1:6, 7, 8, 14, 15, 17, and 20. Raqia means to expand or stretch something. So, in the original Hebrew text of Genesis the "expanse" of the heavens/space, never was or never will mean God created a dome on the second day of creation. Even the verb "raqa" Strong's H7554 means the act of spreading out or stretching something.

If the firmament/expanse is really a dome or arch as flat-earthers claim, then the Hebrew word "Kippah" [בפה פיפה] (dome) [1] would have been used in the Genesis narrative and not Raqia. Kippah is derived from the Hebrew words "kaphaph," Strong's H3721, which means to bend or bow something. Also, the Hebrew word for an arch was not used in Genesis. Therefore, we have two Hebrew words that would have fit the concept of a dome perfectly, but they're not used in Genesis. Why not? Because the sky above us is not a dome. Flat Earthers Debunked!



The Bible frequently recalls how God spread out or expanded the heavens (space). This spreading out, is the opposite of bending and enclosing space over the earth as a dome. Therefore, the choice of Hebrew words in Genesis, speaks against the concept of a dome over the earth. God created an expansive, open universe to show his greatness and that's what we observe – Not a closed dome over us! Flat Earthers


"I was there when he established the heavens, when he drew the horizon on the oceans." Proverbs 8:27 NLT

"He created the horizon when he separated the waters; he set the boundary between day and night." Job 26:10 NLT

"And God made the firmament, and divided the waters which were under the firmament from the waters which were above the firmament: and it was so." KJV Genesis 1:7

He created a horizon (the earths curve/ the horizon) between the waters below (the sea) and the waters above (the sky). The horizon which is at the earth's curve is the end of the earth and start of the sky/space heavens. What did God name the firmament? Heaven! (Genesis 1:8). Where do the birds fly? In the open firmament/heavens/sky (Genesis 1:20).

However, with the flat earth model the start of their firmament/sky/space is not on the ocean waters. Their dome is beyond some supposed ice wall in flat-earther no man's land past Antarctica, but what we observe is the sky starts at our horizon. -- Flat-Earthers Debunked!

Amos 9:6, in the King James version, reads as follows:

"It is he that buildeth his stories in the heaven, and hath founded his troop in the earth; he that calleth for the waters of the sea, and poureth them out upon the face of the earth: The LORD is his name." KJV

Founded could mean appoint, ordain, or establish.

The Young's Literal Translation (YLT) reads:

"Who is building in the heavens His upper chambers; As to His troop, Upon earth He hath founded it, Who is calling for the waters of the sea, And poureth them out on the face of the land, Jehovah is His name."

The Hebrew word "aguddah" has four occurrences in the Bible:

Exodus 12:22 - A bunch of Hyssops -- Not an arch, vault, or dome!

2 Samuel 2:25 - Troop -- Not an arch, vault, or dome!

Isaiah 58:6 - Burdens/Bands -- Not an arch, vault, or dome!

Amos 918/380/2014 should Amos 9:6 be different from how the word is translated in other parts of the Bible?

DEBUNKED: It's funny to see flat-earthers post scriptures that say the sun rises and sets when it's impossible for the sun to rise and set under their flat earth model. They claim their sunrise and sunset is the result of a vanishing point effect or "perspective." If that's their model, then it's not possible for the vanishing point to create the effect of the sun rising with the tip of the sun first and then the bottom of the sun last or the sunset in the reverse order hidden behind the horizon. Only a curved earth can create that effect. The vanishing point effect would not cut off portions of an object and have it gradually appear as a whole as it get's closer to you. So, the sun setting or rising over the horizon is proof the earth is a globe. With a vanishing point perspective, things only get smaller as they get further away. However, we don't see the sun getting smaller we see the sun staying the same size or even getting larger when it goes over the curvature of the earth. Therefore, the flat earth vanishing point excuse is debunked. In addition, according to flat earth models the sun and moon are rotating 620 to 3000 miles above the earth, so a vanishing point perspective would not show the sun disappearing close to the earth's surface.



HEBREW WORD STUDY – THE SUN ALSO ARISES – ZARACH HASHEMESH זרח השׁמשׁ

Ecclesiastes 1:5: "The sun also rises, and the sun goes down, and hastens to his place where he arose."

Let me share with you something very profound spoken by the wisest man on earth through the inspiration of God. "The sun also rises..." Isn't that amazing? Here all the time you thought Ernest Hemingway made that up for his novel. Not only that the sun also goes down. If not for King Solomon we would probably never know that.

Throughout Scripture, we find YAH is telling us things that are very obvious. Why would YAH waste precious time telling us things that we already know? I mean YAH is only opening Himself up for attack with that statement as we already know that the sun does not rise nor does it set. Science shows that the sun is stationary and it is the earth that causes the illusion of a sun rising and setting. I mean that is big or was big for the church in the Middle Ages and caused all sorts of havoc, just ask Galileo. Galileo had the Arch Bishops of the church look into his telescope to prove the earth revolved around the sun and not the sun around the earth. The Arch Bishops saw in the telescope the revolving moons around Jupiter proving that not all heavenly bodies revolved around the earth and the Arch Bishops said; "Yeah, we see it but everything still revolves around the earth because that is the way the church interprets the Bible and the church is never wrong."

Actually, there are many usages for the word rise in Hebrew, zarach. Zarach could also mean to appear, the sun simply appears in the morning. Use that word and there is no argument if the sun rises or not. Of course, church tradition teaches the translation should be rise and therefore even faced with evidence it doesn't they would not back down, it was after all dogma. The same goes for the sun going down which is the Hebrew word bo and has all kinds of usages, including the idea of being brought in or disappearing.


So if this obvious statement in Scripture was not to establish some dogma, why make it.

True, it is serving as an illustration and perhaps that is all. However the Jewish sages teach that when Scripture teaches something that is so obvious like the sun rising and setting, then it is a remez, that is a hint that there is a much deeper meaning than the surface meaning.

I think Ecclesiastes tells us more than we realize how certain people become powerful instruments of Yahuah. Zechariah 4:6: "Not by might, nor by power, but by my spirit, saith Yahuah of hosts." No pastor can call their son or daughter to take over his ministry, nor can he appoint some trusted friend to take over his work. Only Yahuah controls the zarach and the bo of the shemesh. Now that is profound.

Flat Earther's Claim: In The Matthew, Tyndale, and Great Bibles 2 Samuel 11:11 Says The

Earth is Flat

2 Samuel 11:11 - "And Vrias sayd vnto Dauid: the arck and Israel & Iuda dwell in pauilions: & my Lord loab and the seruauntes of my Lorde lye in tentes vpon the <u>flat earthe</u>: and shulde I then go into myne house, to eate and to dryncke & to lye wyth my wyfe? By thy lyfe and as sure as thy soule lyueth, I wyll not do that thyng." (Matthew Bible)

DEBUNKED: Flat-earthers make a big deal about the fact the Matthew, Tyndale, and Great Bibles read "flat earth" instead of "open fields" as seen in the King James and other translations. Some translations also read "Face of the earth" or "face of the ground" So, are the Matthew, Tyndale, and Great Bibles confirming the earth is flat? Not at all. Flat-earthers in their hysterics to find proof for their flawed teachings are elevating this into something it's not.

Flat-earthers need to calm down, take a deep breath, and pay attention. This verse has nothing to do with planet earth. So, just because the Matthew Tyndale, and Great Bibles say "flat earthe" or "flatt erthe" (flat earth), it does not prove planet earth is flat. Here's why, because this verse is not talking about the planet as a whole, it's talking about a field where David's army was camping. In the original Hebrew text, the word "haśśādeh" does not mean earth. This word occurs about 131 times in the Old Testament and almost everytime it occurs it means "field" or "fields." Sometimes it's translated as wild, country, or the ground.

The word for "flat" in the Matthew, Tyndale, and Great bibles is a translation of the Hebrew word "pənê," from Strong's H6440 and it means "open." H6440 is the word for face or surface -- Not Flat. Even the Septuagint translates this word as open or face -- Not Flat.

In addition, the translators of the Matthew, Tyndale, and Great Bibles are using the word earth in the context of the dry land (Genesis 1:10). Therefore, the obvious conclusion is the translators of these three Bibles are trying to get across the message that David's army was sleeping flat on the ground of the field. This is why Uriah did not feel right sleeping in the comfort of his bed at home while his fellow warriors were sleeping on a hard ground. There is nothing wrong with their translation unless you want to exploit it and turn it into a different message from what the translators intended it to be, just to push an agenda.

Nevertheless, the original text and the majority of translations show that David's army slept in an open field or on the face (surface) of the ground 17/10/26/2016 there is no evidence here that the planet is flat.

We could go on and on debunking the Flat Earth — but we think we've made our point and there is a lesson to be learned. Don't use Scripture without actually knowing what the Scriptures say! It's important to research and dig, that's the only way to come to a logical conclusion, and for us, it's not a Flat Earth!!



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
