REBELLION[®]


30:1

“O rebellious, obstinate and defiant children!” declares Yahuah, “to make and manufacture a plan or scheme from your own counsel, but not from Me, and pour out a drink offering to an idol, but not from My Spirit, so as to add sin and iniquity to sin and destruction.”



30:2

Who walks and goes down to Egypt,
but they do not ask or inquire of My
mouth or seek My communication, to
take refuge and seek safety in the
protection of Pharaoh and to take
refuge and seek safety in the shadow
of Egypt.

Everyone will start to stink, bringing shame in a manner that is in defiance of a proper standard and is an embarrassment, because a people cannot profit or find value and use from them, not for help and not for profiting or usefulness, but for shame and scorn and also for disgrace.



30:6

An oracle or pronouncement of the animals of Negev: Through the land of trouble, anguish and distress and oppression, of lioness and lion, among them snake and flying serpent causing great trouble and dire consequences; they carry their wealth on the backs of male donkeys and their treasures on the humps of camels, to a people that cannot profit or find value from them.

30:7

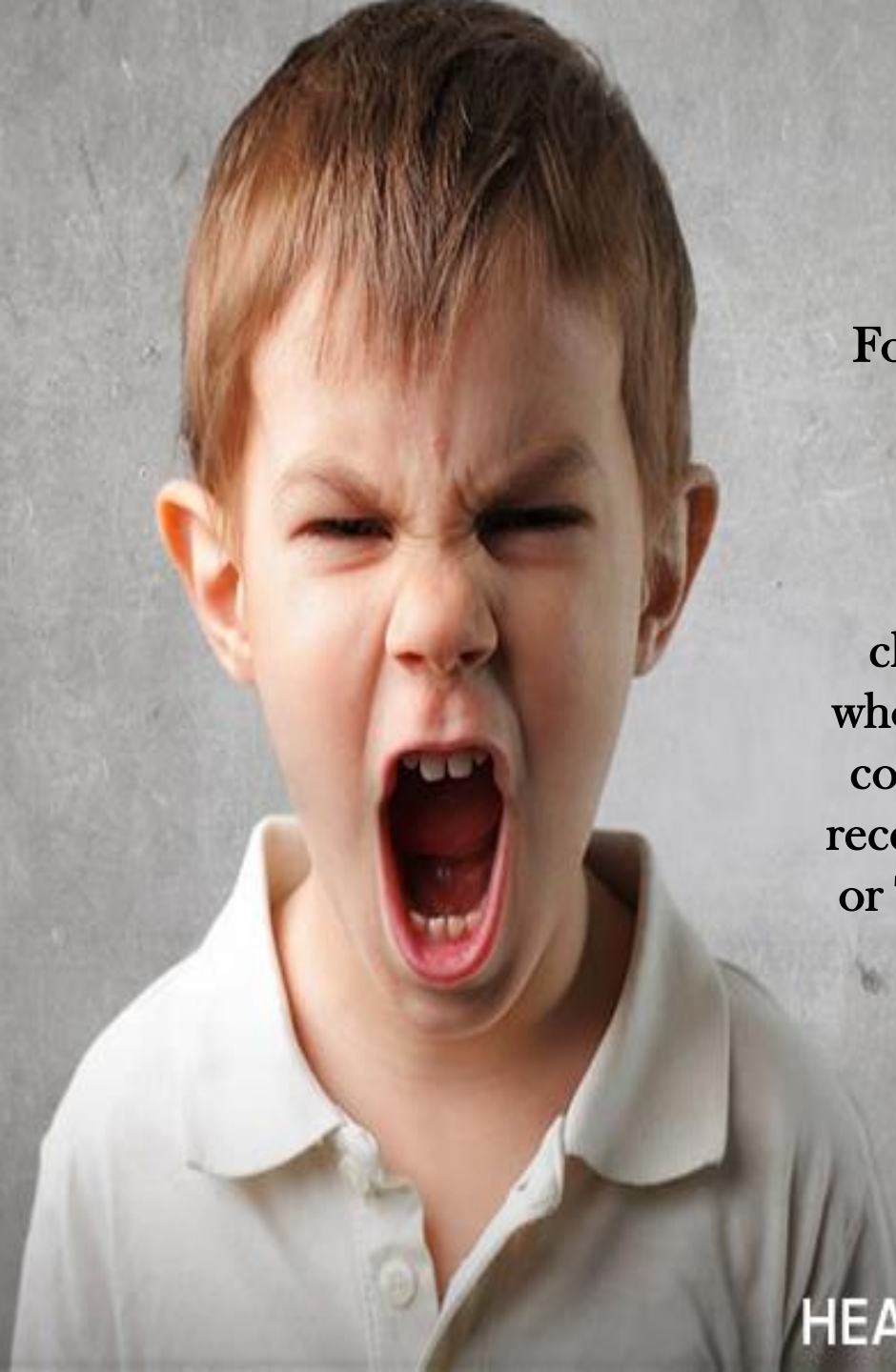
For Egyptians are inclined to help with vanity, idols, futility and emptiness, therefore I have called this one “Rahab the Do-Nothing sea monster that is unable to act (referring to Egypt as an impotent power), they are sitting.”

Now go write it on a tablet with them, and inscribe it

will be the last or the end time , forever, forever.

For it is a people of

Therefore the Set-Apart One of
Yahsharal says this: “Because
you are rejecting with disdain this
word and you trust and believe in
oppression, tyranny and cunning
deviousness which you rely and
depend on,



30:13

Therefore this
iniquity and
punishment shall
come like a breach
and gap about to fall,
bulging out on a high
weak wall that breaks
suddenly and
unexpectedly, in an
instant.

30:14

And He breaks and smashes it like a vessel of a potter breaks, fracturing into pieces, that is crushed; He has no compassion and takes no pity or mercy on, and no potsherds is found among its fragments to take fire from the hearth, or to skim water from the cistern.






30:15

Master Yahuah, the Set-Apart One of Yahsharal, said this: “In returning in repentance and peace you shall be saved and delivered; your strength shall be in quietness and relief and in trust and faith.” But you were not willing,



30:16

And you said, “No! For we flee (yiqtol) leaving in haste on horses!” Therefore you shall flee (yiqtol) and be very afraid! And, “We will ride swift and fast horses!” Therefore your pursuers who are your persecutors shall be swift (yiqtol) making you of no value and you will find no peace!



30:17

One thousand because of and from a threat and rebuke of disapproval of one, because of a threat and rebuke of disapproval of five you shall flee, until you are left as a reminder like a flagstaff or a long pole on top of a mountain, and like a signal or reminder on a hill.

30:18

Therefore Yahuah waits
with patience to be
gracious, showing
compassion to you, and
therefore He will rise up
to show you forgiveness
and mercy, for Yahuah is
an Eternal of justice,
decision and judgement;
blessed and happy all
those who wait and are
patient for Him.



30:19

Indeed people will
live in Zion; in
Jerusalem, you will
surely not weep or be
mournful. Surely He
will be gracious and
patient, showing great
kindness to you when
He hears the sound
of your cry for help,
He will answer you.

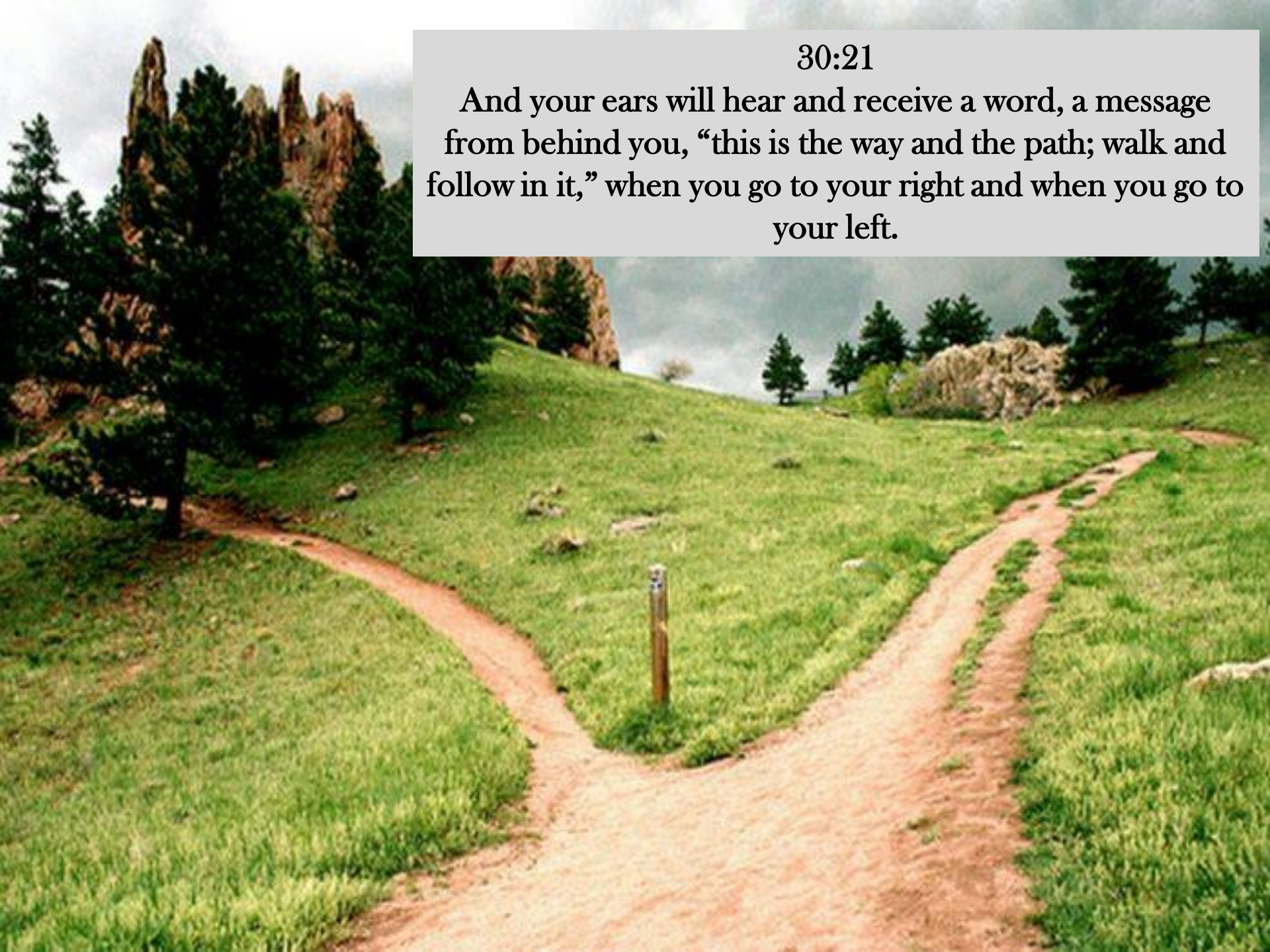




30:20
And Eternal will give you the
bread of distress and anguish
and the water of oppression and
affliction, but your teachers will
not hide themselves and their

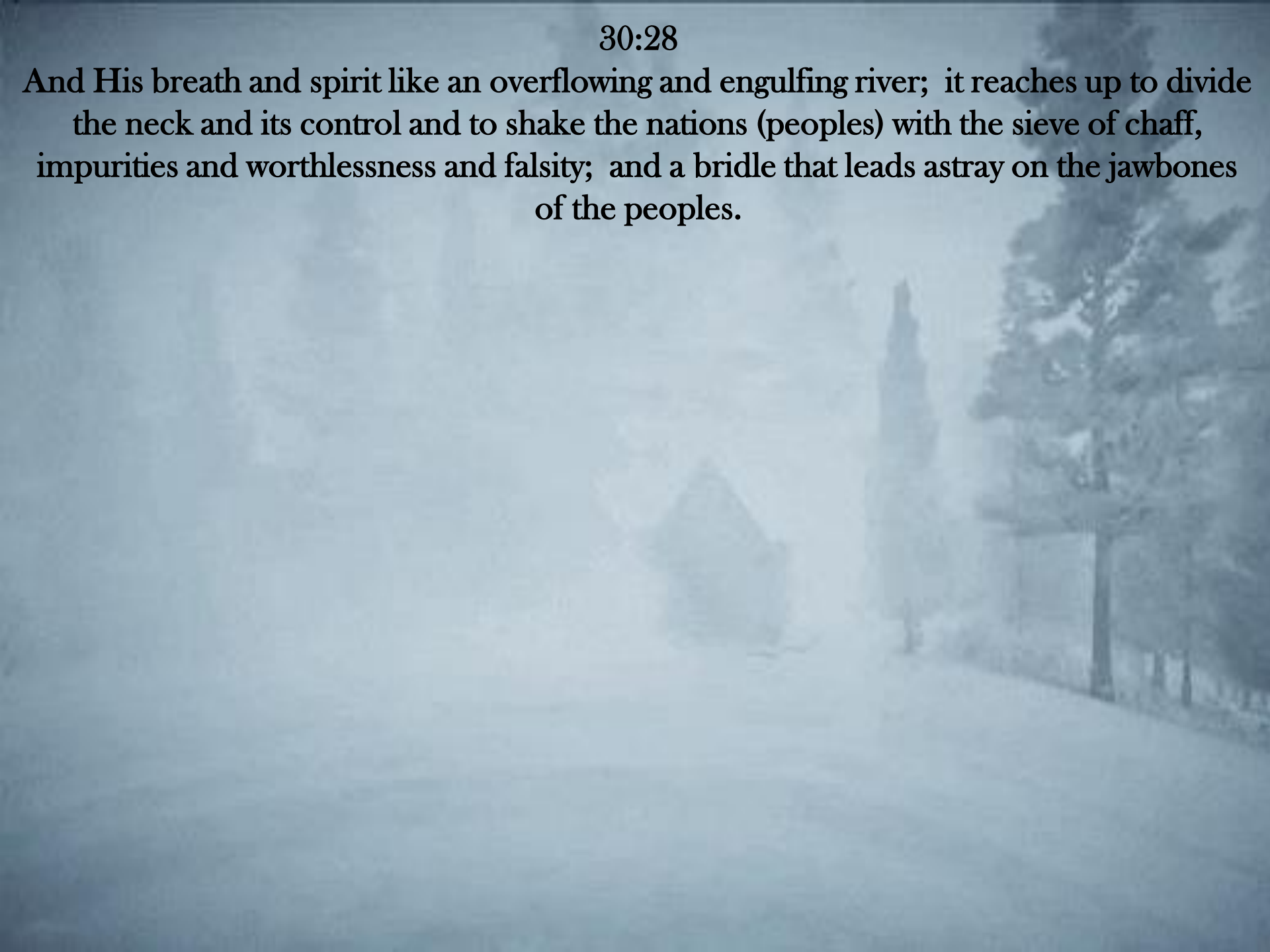


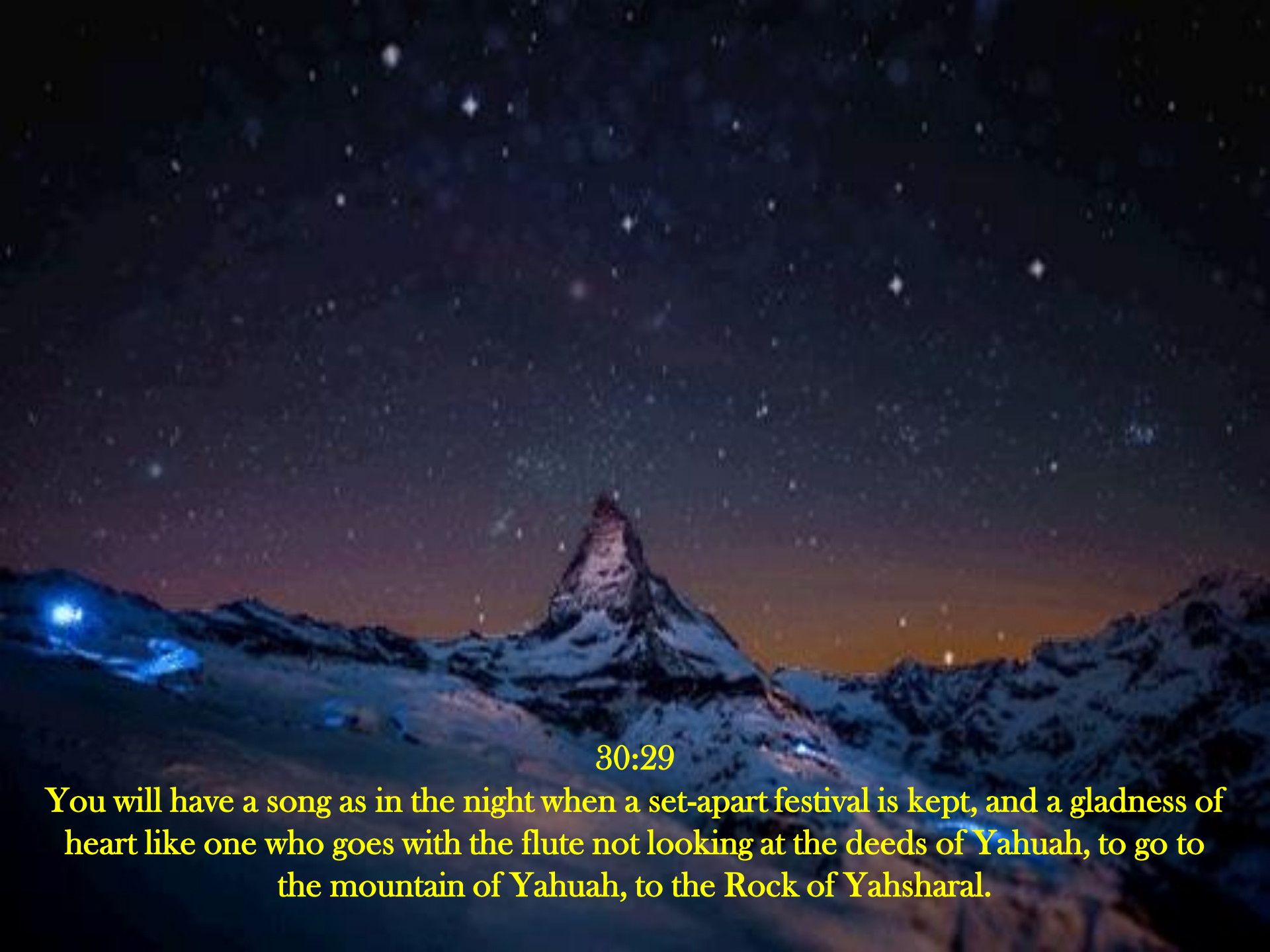
30:27

Look and behold! The name, reputation and authority of Yahuah comes from afar, burning and consumed with His anger and wrath and heaviness and thick mass of cloud and burden of distress. His lips are full of indignation and anger, and His tongue, speaking words is like a devouring and all consuming fire.

And His breath and spirit like an overflowing and engulfing river; it reaches up to divide the neck and its control and to shake the nations (peoples) with the sieve of chaff, impurities and worthlessness and falsity; and a bridle that leads astray on the jawbones of the peoples.

You will have a song as in the night when a set-apart festival is kept, and a gladness of heart like one who goes with the flute not looking at the deeds of Yahuah, to go to the mountain of Yahuah, to the Rock of Yahsharal.

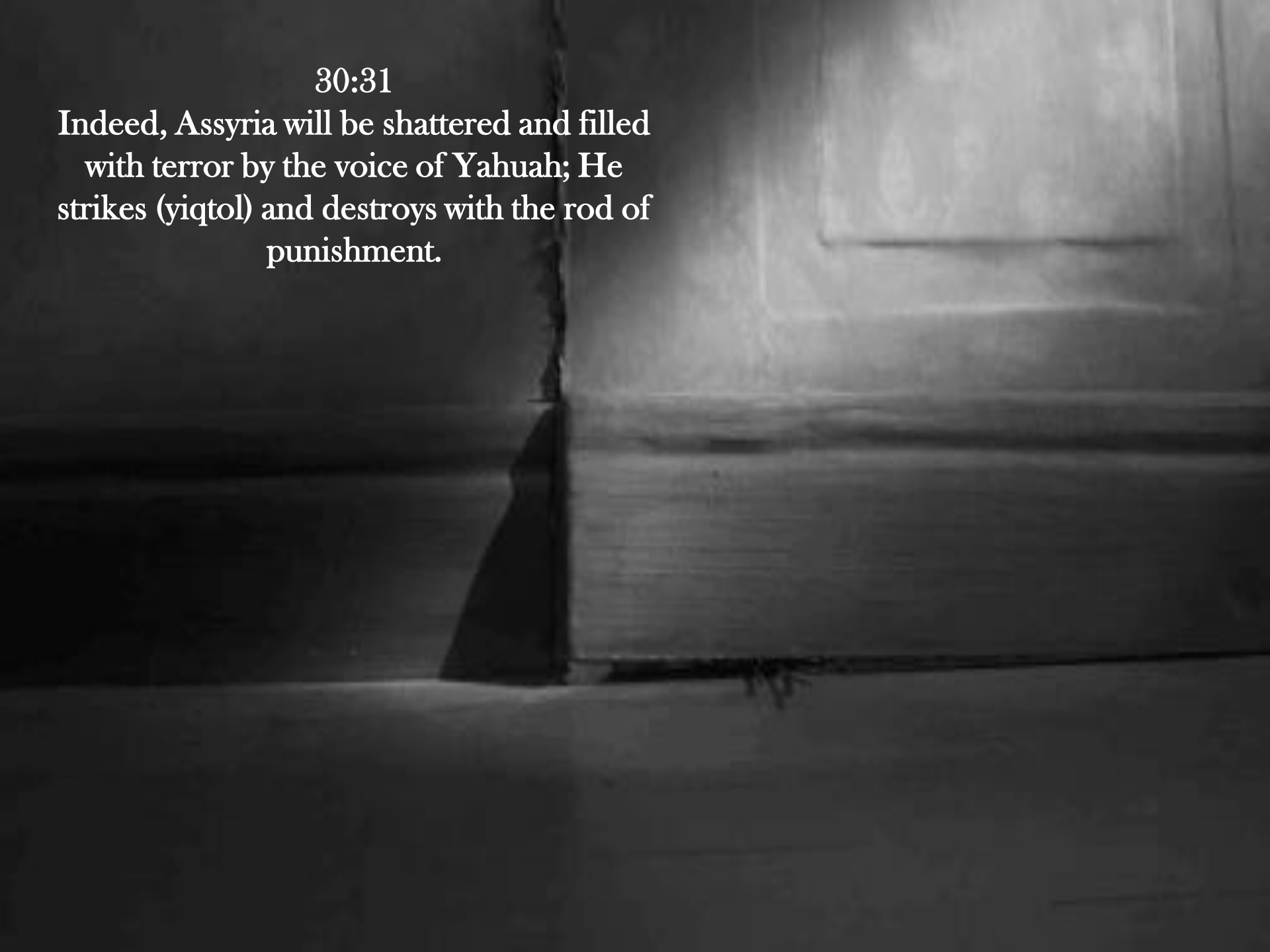

Then Yahuah will cause and allow the majesty and splendor of His voice to be heard, and He will cause and allow the descent of His arm to be seen, in furious rage and anger and a flame of devouring and consuming fire, with a cloudburst and a rainstorm and stones of hail.

And every stroke and blow of the staff of foundation that Yahuah lays will be on it with timbrels and lyres, and He will fight against it with battles brandishing.

For Topheth (Valley of Ben Hinnom-the place of defilement and death) has been prepared and put in order from yesterday; indeed, it is made ready for the king/leader. He makes its pile of wood deep and wide; he makes fire and wood abundant. The breath and anger of Yahuah burns in it like a stream of sulfur and brimstone.
