



Our Methodology

The tricky thing about going chronological is that we get hints of an instruction way before it was written down in Exodus. This will be a great eye opener as we go through Genesis. They knew of these things from somewhere. Adam and Hawah must have taught their children and now that the 365 books of Enoch are lost, we do not have an accurate picture of the first mention of these things.

We have chosen to deal with this by acknowledging the first mention of a subject but will not address it fully until the actual instruction is given. We want to recreate the feeling of starting from scratch. It seems to us that Yahuah watched mankind and as we progressed kept note of the things which caused us to stumble the most. It was then at Sinai that Yahuah was able to set in stone the things for us to guard against and remember that would keep us on the path. But we will see that the moral code was already in practice as well as some ceremonial things. How could it be otherwise? Everyone has had the information they needed to come to love and choose Yahuah, if He has chosen them. There are some things that prevent Him from choosing certain creations, so let us keep that in mind, even if we do not fully understand it.



It is important to notice the progression that has just taken place.

- 17:1 Abram had to continue to walk blameless before Yahuah's face to be changed into a perfected, completely whole and without defect child of Yahuah. He had proved to Yahuah he was "all in" and now must continue to do so all his life.
- 17:2 THEN Yahuah says He will present His covenant between Him and Abram- the way in which He will make him the father of huge people groups. Because Abram had succeeded in his walk Yahuah was now ready to take him to the next step. Let us not forget it took Abram 99 years to get to this point.
- 17:5 Yahuah officially changes Abram to Abraham adding the Hey because he reached out to Yahuah and paid attention. Abraham would now forever have this name but something more significant needed to happen before the "Everlasting" Covenant would be in full force.
- 17:7 Yahuah was going to establish several physical marks as an outward symbol of commitment to His Covenant.
- 17:8 Yahuah deeded the land of Canaan to Abraham and his offspring. This
 is the second "Everlasting" Covenant".
- 17:9 As always, Yahuah tells Abraham they will need to SHAMAR their side of the Covenant to reap the benefits of it.

WHAT IS AN Everlasting Covenant?

We will be looking at all the Scripture that has these words but it is important to realize that what is everlasting is Yahuah's commitment to keeping His side of the Covenant. There is only one "Everlasting" Covenant where mankind is not expected to do anything and that was the Rainbow Covenant. That was a Covenant Yahuah made with Himself as a reminder.

All the others we are expected to shamar-guard His Covenant terms and conditions. If we do not, Yahuah is under no obligation to provide the benefits He has promised.

Does that mean if we break it once or twice or fill in the blank that we have lost out on the blessing? No of course not. Yahuah in His brilliancy has provided the clause of Teshuva! Repent, stop what we are doing wrong, turn around and face Him, apologize and endeavor to not continue to do that which is against the Covenant and return to the path!

His offer is Eternal. Our benefit of the Covenant is conditional upon the terms and conditions. That is why once saved always saved is a dangerous doctrine that teach you can turn from Yahuah and He will still honor the Covenant. That is not true!

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Everlasting Covenant

Gen 17:10 "¬N as a strong covenant mark, this is My covenant which you will guard, protect, be careful about, conform your actions to (shamar) between Me and you, and your offspring after you ¬N as a strong covenant mark: Every male child among you will be circumcised.

Vahuah wants a voluntary mark to be put on His male children that once done cannot be easily taken back. This does not mean that the child or man does not have free will to walk away. They do. But they should have a sign they look at everyday to remind them what they walked away from. You can take off your Tzitzits and forget about it. But not so with Circumcision. It is very painful and extremely difficult to reverse it. Yahuah wants his MEN to know that from that time forward, all seed passing through the circumcision, has a favored beginning of becoming a child of Yahuah. The children of circumcised fathers should be very grateful even if it was done as a secular gesture. What a gift, if non covenanted parents have this procedure done for their sons. However, when they do it before 8 days after birth there is a greater health risk to the child. Gen 17:11 "And you will circumcise **¬№** as a strong covenant mark the flesh of your foreskin, and it will come to exist as a sign of the Covenant between Me and you.

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What a great privilege a man has to be able to carry a permanent sign of the Covenant! At this point in time, Yahuah increased the visual reminder so that to shamar- guard His Covenant would be harder to forget and easier to pass down to future generations. The timing in history is getting more serious and narrower in focus, as Yahuah is setting in motion the requirements of the line in which Yahusha will come from. Gen 17:12 "And at eight days old, you, yourselves will circumcise every male in your lineage. And he who is a servant born in your house and the one acquired with money from any foreigner who is not out of your offspring.

There is another important reason for a man of Yahuah's Covenant to be circumcised as an outward sign. That is proper behavior. Usually when something has been designated as set apart, those who are of that understanding will treat that item with great reverence. It would not be used frivolously and definitely not used in a violent sexual act against a woman or a man.

If a man is circumcised and knows the true meaning behind it, he should be making sure that when he is engaging in activity with it, it is honorable to Yahuah. Hopefully the point is getting through.

Here we see another Covenant that is of the everlasting type. Everlasting to Yahuah. Everlasting with consequences if mankind does not shamar -guard to preserve it.

Speaking of consequences, this is amazingly obvious. If a man is not circumcised, he is obviously not concerned with being in Covenant with Yahuah. This can be of no fault of his own. His parents did not start him off in life with this advantage. It is way more painful to get it done after 8 days old. But it must be done. No exceptions. The proof of this will be in the next few verses. It also means he is not engaged with people of the Covenant. So by logic, he is separated from people who do know the importance and meaning of circumcision. By the same token, just because a man is circumcised does not mean he is in Covenant. He has met the first requirement of it (if done as a baby) but it is still his decision, to take advantage of being in Yahuah's Covenant according to all the terms and conditions.

Sharai's name which meant "my princess", now has the meaning of "noble woman" with the added Hey and taking away the Yod. And that is exactly what she became. No longer a princess to just Abraham, but the mother of kings for a very important lineage to come. Gen 17:16 "Then I will kneel down and bless her **¬×** as a strong covenant mark and also give you a son by her. And I will kneel down and bless her, and she will cause to exist nations. Sovereigns of peoples are to be from her."

This is the sweetest picture of tenderness and the patience of our amazing Father. Firstly, the personal attention given to Sharah to make sure that this will be a special child -born in her advanced age as a miracle. Her name change as a sign to her that this indeed is a promise Yahuah intended to keep. Do you understand now why Sharah was barren up until this point? Yahuah had to patiently wait until Abram fulfilled the first 6 steps we laid out at the beginning of this study. Then Yahuah could change his name to Abraham and introduce him to the concept of circumcision. With that done, Sha'rai was ready to become the mother of many nations and kings. Because the seed that would be planted would come through the sign of the "Everlasting" covenant- circumcision. Yahuah will make sure His will is done, and done the correct way. No cutting (excuse the pun) corners. Ok in this case there is some physical cutting of corners hahaha.

Gen 17:17 And Abraham fell on his face and laughed, and said in his heart, "Can a man who is a hundred years old begat a child? Or can Sharah, at the age of ninety years old, give birth?" 17:18 And Abraham said to Yahuah, "Oh, let Yahshama'ale live before You!"

Abraham knew this would be a miracle of miracles. But he is still thinking horizontally - man's easy way. Yahshama'ale is already here. Can't you use him instead? Thinking vertically, anything is possible for Yahuah. By creating this miracle, Yahuah was giving to Abraham and Sharah the gift she had longed for all her life. In that culture she had great shame of not being able to bear Abraham a child. With this miracle not only is the child special, Sharah's whole internal body is transformed to physically be able to endure having this child and both come out of this healthy. She would now be elevated above the women who had made her feel less than.

Everlasting Covenant

Gen 17:19 And Yahuah said, "No, Sharah your wife will bear a son to you, and you shall call ¬ℵ as a strong covenant mark his name Yah'shaq. And I will establish ¬ℵ as a strong covenant mark, My covenant with him, as a Covenant for an indeterminate and unending time in the future^{**} and to his offspring after him.

Yahuah will never forget a promise. Not only did He promise this to Hagar, but He is now telling Abraham not to worry about his first born. And then He adds more details about his future. 12 rulers will come from him, which matches Yah'shaq. But Yahuah knows He will not bring His son from this line. Gen 17:21 "But TR Behold-pay strong attention to this sign- My Covenant I establish with Yah'shaq, whom Sharah will to bear to you at the appointed time next year."



Confirming this, Yahuah specifically states that the Covenant Abraham is entering into, is going to be through Yah'shaq. Then He sets a specific time frame. Wow how cool is that. Only Yahuah should be setting dates of prophecy! Gen 17:22 And when He finished speaking with him **TN** as a strong covenant mark, Yahuah's essence lifted up above from Abraham.





The amazing example of Abraham. Yahuah says it, he does it.

Gen 17:24 So Abraham was ninety-nine years old when he was circumcised in the flesh of his foreskin. Gen 17:25 And Yahshama'ale his son was thirteen years old when he was circumcised א (as a strong covenant mark)in the flesh of his foreskin. Gen 17:26 Abraham and his son Yahshama'ale were circumcised that same day. Gen 17:27 And all the men of his house, those born in the house or those acquired by money from א (as a strong covenant mark) a son of a foreigner, were circumcised with him א (as a strong covenant mark).



Here is the proof that if you are a male and you want to enter into this Covenant with Yahuah, no matter your age, you must be circumcised. If Abraham can do it at 99, there is no excuse if you trust Yahuah to bring you through it. Yah is not specific on the amount that is cut, which in older males may be a great help in compliance.

Everlasting Covenant

We looked up the phrase "everlasting covenant" in Blue Letter Bible. It came back with 14 matches in the Tanakh. The first four we have already looked at. Please forgive the offending titles.

> Gen 9:16 And the bow shall be in the cloud; and I will look upon it, that I may remember the everlasting covenant between God and every living creature of all flesh that *is* upon the earth.

- Gen 17:7 And I will establish my covenant between me and thee and thy seed after thee in their generations for an everlasting covenant, to be a God unto thee, and to thy seed after thee.
- Gen 17:13 He that is born in thy house, and he that is bought with thy money, must needs be circumcised: and my covenant shall be in your flesh for an everlasting covenant.
- Gen 17:19 And God said, Sarah thy wife shall bear thee a son indeed; and thou shalt call his name Isaac: and I will establish my covenant with him for an everlasting covenant, and with his seed after him.

- Lev 24:8 Every sabbath he shall set it in order before the LORD continually, *being taken* from the children of Israel by an everlasting covenant.
- 2Sa 23:5 Although my house be not so with God; yet he hath made with me an everlasting covenant, ordered in all things, and sure: for this is all my salvation, and all my desire, although he make it not to grow.
- ICh 16:17 And hath confirmed the same to Jacob for a law, and to Israel for an everlasting covenant,
- Psa 105:10 And confirmed the same unto Jacob for a law, and to Israel for an everlasting covenant:
- Isa 24:5 The earth also is defiled under the inhabitants thereof; because they have transgressed the laws, changed the ordinance, broken the everlasting covenant.
- Isa 55:3 Incline your ear, and come unto me: hear, and your soul shall live; and I will make an <u>everlasting covenant</u> with you, even the sure mercies of David.
- Isa 61:8 For I the LORD love judgment, I hate robbery for burnt offering; and I will direct their work in truth, and I will make an everlasting covenant with them.
- Jer 32:40 And I will make an <u>everlasting covenant</u> with them, that I will not turn away from them, to do them good; but I will put my fear in their hearts, that they shall not depart from me.
- Eze 16:60 Nevertheless I will remember my covenant with thee in the days of thy youth, and I will establish unto thee an everlasting covenant.
- Eze 37:26 Moreover I will make a <u>covenant</u> of peace with them; it shall be an <u>everlasting covenant</u> with them: and I will place them, and multiply them, and will set my sanctuary in the midst of them for evermore.

The remaining 10 are mentions of more promises and also where the "Everlasting" part was pretty short lived on our side and Yahuah was pretty upset. He takes this very seriously and so should we.

21. When we trust Yahuah with our everything, we give to Him the highest praise we can give Him.


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
