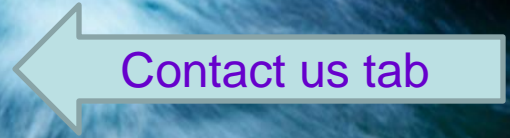
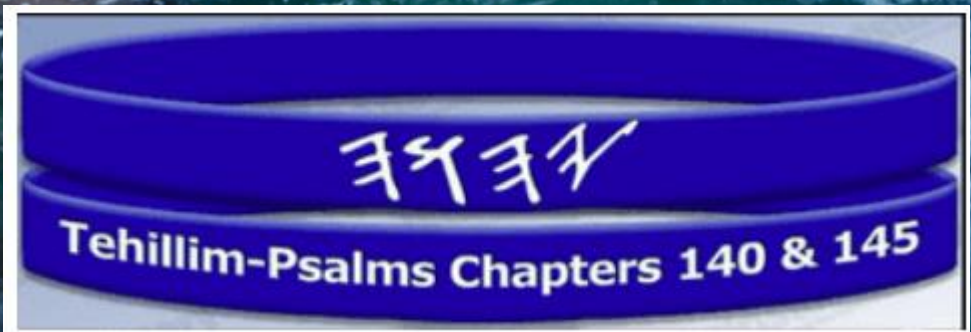

It is important to note these were not enoshm H582- mortal men, or common people. This is actually a slur on these messengers of Yahuah. Look at the root word H605 Anash.

אָנִיֵּשׁ 'ānash, aw-nash'; a primitive root; to be frail, feeble, or (figuratively) melancholy:—desperate(-ly wicked), incurable, sick, woeful.

Remember, Hebrew words that spring from one another should carry with them the root meaning but expanded. They are a family of words - somehow related to each other. These messengers, who were in human form, did not carry any of the characteristics of Anash. But the ones they came to spy out certainly did. Human kind H582 certainly does. We would say the lying pens of the scribes have messed with what this word originally was. To imply that Yahuah would send "desperately wicked men", who came from His realm, to undertake this mission is edging on blasphemy, in our opinion.



- Gen 21:1 And יהוה visited Sarah as He had said, and יהוה did for Sarah as He had spoken. 21:2 So Sarah conceived and bore Abraham a son in his old age, at the appointed time of which Yahuah had spoken to him. 21:3 And Abraham called the name of his son who was born to him, whom Sarah bore to him, Yah’shaq.

19. We will stop complaining about our circumstances and ask Yah to show us what we need to learn from them.

20. We will stop grumbling against others on the path to Yahuah

21. We understand the importance and seriousness of making a Covenant with Yahuah.

22. The Marriage Covenant should be highly valued and the roles of the husband and wife should be thoroughly understood.

23. We will be on guard in our relationships.

24. We are responsible for the birds, fish, creeping creatures, livestock.

25. We are responsible for maintaining the earths population.

26. We should be eating only from plants that have reproductive seeds.

27. We will be careful to not eat anything that is still alive with the blood in it.

28. Life is precious and it represents the image of Yahuah. We will do all we can to protect life and never condone premeditated murder.
