Our Methodology


As always, anything written in comic sans font, we inserted in articles as corrections or are our narration.





If *mules* or *gimmels* were to be more highly prized than donkeys *chamor* in Biblical times then why does the instruction in Exodus 20 direct us to not covet our neighbors *mules* or *gimmels* rather than *chamors* or *donkeys*? An even better question would be why does Yahuah even list the things we are not to covet?

It does not give a list of things not to steal, it just says *don't steal*. I mean my neighbor doesn't even have an ox or donkey and I certainly would not covet his pet pit bull dog Sparky. I believe the answer lies in the Hebrew word for *covet*. It is the word *chamed* which is closely related to the word *chamor*, or *donkey*. It actually carries the same Semitic root and would suggest that there is a play on words. The *chamor* (donkey) in its verbal form means to be *agitated*, to ferment or to be obstinate. That is a good description of a donkey. Actually, the word *chamor* is sometimes used for *wine*. The old saying should be rendered as *stubborn as a donkey*, not *as a mule*. The word *chamed* (*covet*) means an object of desire or something in which you delight. I once heard a Jewish grandmother refer to her granddaughter as her little *chamed* - someone she desired to be with. So, when we are directed not to covet, it is more than just to desire something that belongs to our neighbor but we are not even to delight in something owned by our neighbor, if we are tempted by that desire to have that specific thing, to steal it. Taking something that is not ours legally as well.



It seems the instruction runs from the most important possession of your neighbor to the least important. It starts with not coveting his wife to his manservant and maidservant to his ox and finally his *chamor*, the thing that is least value in his household. That is where we might find a play on words. We are not to *chamed* (delight, desire) something that is *chamor* (that which is the least valuable). How many times have you heard someone say, "Well, he will never miss it anyways." "He has a millions dollars in the bank, he will never miss the thousand I can con him out of."



When we see the list of the Ten Instructions it often just says, "You shalt not covet." But that is not what Yahuah is saying. It is ok to covert, chamed (delight, desire), like that Jewish grandmother chamed her granddaughter. What we are instructed to not do is chamed (delight, desire) something that belongs to our neighbor even that which is of the least value, causing you to seek to own it. Well, at least I have no problem in that department with Sparky the Wonder dog.

The meanings of this letter are "outside," as the function of the wall is to protect the occupants from the elements, half, as the wall in the middle of the tent divides the tent into the male and female sections, and secular, as something that is outside.

History & Reconstruction

The Early Semitic pictograph for this letter is **m**, a picture of waves of water. This pictograph has the meanings of liquid, water and sea, mighty and massive from the size of the sea and chaos from the storms of the sea.

History & Reconstruction

There are two possibilities for the original Early Semitic pictograph for this letter, the picture of a fish $-\infty$ and a picture of a door $-\infty$. The Modern Hebrew name for this letter is *dalet* and means "door." The word *dalet* is a derivative of the parent root *dal* also meaning "door." The Arabic name for this letter is *dal* giving support to the parent root as the original name. As the Hebrew word for a "fish" is dag, it is unlikely that the ∞ is the pictograph for this letter but, rather the ∇ .



It is hard to get away from the Garden as we think of this word for so many reasons. Chaim explained that this word is about an object of desire or something we delight in. Dennis provided the insight that this is about guarding our thoughts against taking something that belongs to someone else.

We have talked before about the rule of first mention when looking at a word to get meanings in Scripture. Guess where this is first mentioned!

Gen 2:9 And out of the ground יהוה Eternal made every tree grow that is (*chamed*) pleasant to the sight and good for food, with the tree of life in the midst of the garden and the tree of the knowledge of good and evil.

Gen 3:6 And the woman saw that the tree was good for food, that it was (tah-avaw') pleasant to the eyes, and a tree (*chamed*) desirable to make one wise, and she took of its fruit and ate. And she also gave to her husband with her, and he ate. So Yahuah made every tree grow that is (chamed) pleasant to the sight and good for food and the tree of Knowledge of Good and

Evil also was good for food, that it was pleasant (tah-av-aw') to the eyes, but that it was also a tree (chamed) desirable to make one wise. The other tree's fruit was just nourishing to the body. The forbidden tree gave the thought of desiring wisdom they did not possess that belonged to Yahuah. He did not give them permission to have it, thus this word changed to the negative of chamed.

It came to mind when looking this up that when Yahuah told them about this tree, it was not recorded He spoke of not even touching the tree- it is only recorded of Hawah relaying to the influencer what she knew about the instructions regarding the tree.

Hawah made a huge mistake that is a given, but you have to ask a question. At this point in the conversation, the influencer just asked "Is it true that Eternal has said, 'Do not eat of every tree of the garden'?" When she answers that "We are to eat of the fruit of the trees of the garden, but of the fruit of the tree which is in the midst of the garden, Eternal has said, 'Do not eat of it, nor touch it, lest you die.'"

Questions:

- At this point in time did Hawah even know how to lie?
- Could it be possible they were told to not touch the tree and it was not recorded?
- Was it possible to pick the fruit without touching the tree?

I have heard quite a few preachers call her out for "adding to the Scripture" (gosh pot calling the kettle black). But we don't think she did. Why can't this be just more information than was provided in Chapter 2. We see that all the time. So why does this matter?

There is something interesting about the words chosen for covet in her actions.

Adding to that, the play on words in the same verse for the pictograph of chamed- we again see crossing a wall or barrier. Of course the influencer was blocking the view of the evil so she could only see what was dazzling and pleasant. Much like where she was- only different. This place held secret knowledge. How many times has man been told to eat the Word of Yahuah for knowledge? Is it so far fetched that this held the words of Yahuah for them at another time when they were ready to fully digest it for proper nourishment of His word?




