



#### Our Methodology

The tricky thing about going chronological is that we get hints of an instruction way before it was written down in Exodus. This was a great eye opener as we went through Genesis. They knew of these things from somewhere. Adam and Hawah must have taught their children and now that the 365 books of Enoch are lost, we do not have an accurate picture of the first mention of these things.

We have chosen to deal with this by acknowledging the first mention of a subject but will not address it fully until the actual instruction is given. We want to recreate the feeling of starting from scratch. It seems to us that Yahuah watched mankind and as we progressed kept note of the things which caused us to stumble the most. It was then at Sinai that Yahuah was able to set in stone the things for us to guard against and remember that would keep us on the path. But we will see that the moral code was already in practice as well as some ceremonial things. How could it be otherwise? Everyone has had the information they needed to come to love and choose Yahuah, if He has chosen them. There are some things that prevent Him from choosing certain creations, so let us keep that in mind, even if we do not fully understand it. In Part 4 of our journey in the book of Shemot/Exodus, we continue with our study of what it means to be in Covenant with Yahuah. Today's study is our first look at Passover and Unleavened Bread, with discussions of: what to do, how to do it today, and the responsibility of being Yahuah's Chosen paternal kin.

We don't get the clarification of what the name of this month is until Exodus 13:14 where it was called Abib - H24. It means to be tender or green. Example; a young ear of grain. In Exodus 9:31-32 we get the clue the flax and the barley were ruined because the barley was in the head and the flax was in bud. But the wheat and the spelt were not ruined, for they were late crops.

> Think of this as well, the people were "green" in Torah and being of free will. This was a new growth of people Yahuah was raising up to follow His Covenant. How awesome this starts in the Spring!

This is also quite a change, because previously they were on the Egyptian calendar, per Josephus. The Egyptians had the month Thoth as the first month, which is Thisri with the Hebrews, and is our September, or a part of it, so that the beginning of the year was then in the autumnal equinox. Now the Israelites would change to the vernal equinox, for this month of Abib or Nisan (the Chaldean name for it) answers to part of our March and part of April. Another separation from the ways of the gentiles.

Yahuah was taking back time keeping- to His standard and striking another blow to the Egyptian idol Thoth. There was much work to be done to cleanse the people of over 400 years of idolatry.

- Thoth was considered one of the more important deities of the Egyptian pantheon.
- In art, he was often depicted as a man with the head of an ibis or a baboon; these animals were sacred to him.

 The Egyptians credited him as the author of all works of science, religion, philosophy, and magic. 9

Mythology also credits him with the creation of the 365 day calendar.



The Syriac version renders it, "in the month of flowers"; when the flowers were rising up out of the earth, being spring time, and a very fit time to travel in; and this is observed, not only because they might not know what month it was, in such a state of ignorance, because of being slaves in Egypt; but to also point out to them the mercy and goodness of Yahuah to them, in bringing them out at such a seasonable time to travel in, when there were neither heat, nor cold, nor rain.

> "Experts are collecting online data of where and when fields are flowering," Mizrahi tells ISRAEL21c. "We have sightings of rare desert flowers that you only see every 25 years. 



It is important today to eat lamb, roasted - does not have to be over a fire. It is part of the remembrance that Yahuah destroyed the reputation of the biggest idol of Egypt. No other meat will carry the same significance and that is why Yahuah specifically asks us to eat lamb. It is as important as all the other criteria of this feast.


The lambs were too young for the travel before them. A beacon for wild beast which would endanger the people. It was a delicacy which they were not used to eating and last time for a long time they would have meat. 4/03/2020



Amun, Creator and Sun-god, as a Ram. Protecting the Pharaoh Amenhotep III. 1413-1337 B.C. Egypt.



- Amun was one of the most powerful gods in ancient Egypt.
- He was called the 'King of the Gods'.



Amen also Amon, Amun, Ammon was the Egyptian god of life and reproduction, represented as a man with a ram's head.

"Amon was the chief god of the ancient Egyptians during the New Kingdom (1,570-1,090 B.C.). His main certer of worship was Thebes, in Upper Egypt. Amon became identified with Re, the sun god, and was known as Amon-Re, represented in human form, wearing a cylindrical headdress capped by two large feathers, from which a headband hung down loosely over his shoulders."

Avenue of ram-headed sphinxes outside the great temple of Amon at Karnak. The ram was the sacred animal of the sun god (Amon).

This bread commemorates when the people left Egypt in a hurry and did not have time to let their bread rise. It also commemorates them leaving behind the leaven they picked up in Egypt that Yahuah must now cleanse them from.



Bitter Herbs is usually fresh ground horseradish, however sometimes romaine lettuce or a plate of bitter vegetables such as radishes, parsley, and celery are served instead. These bitter herbs symbolize the bitterness of Egyptian slavery. Some prefer mild horseradish, although others say that it doesn't serve its purpose (to remind us of the bitterness of slavery) unless it's hot enough to bring tears to the eyes.

They made their lives bitter with hard labor in brick and mortar and with all kinds of work in the fields; in all their hard labor the Egyptians used them ruthlessly. Exodus 1:14

This meal is to be eaten quickly with shoes on, car keys and purses by the door, gas tanks filled and weapons locked and loaded. There needs to be a sense of urgency.

This is also another proof that the last supper was not a Passover meal, where they lounged at the table and talked a great deal afterward- before heading out to Gethsemane. Also another no-no.

It is a privilege to come together in person, (if possible) for Yahuah's feast. Think of the people who have given up this inheritance right. Very sad indeed. Exod 12:15 'Seven days you shall eat unleavened bread. Indeed on the first day you will cause leaven to cease and be removed from your houses. For whoever eats leavened bread from the first day until the seventh day, that being shall be cut off from and excluded from association with Yah'shar'al.


Whoever would do this for the full feast and does not care is now cut off from associating with Yahuah's Covenant family. This rebellion of disrespect cannot be tolerated. Notice it is for the full feast- from 1<sup>st</sup> to 7<sup>th</sup> day. If it is done by accident once and then the person realize what they did and teshuva, they do not have to be excluded. We are on notice how important keeping the leaven out of our houses is for the full week. Exod 12:16 'And on the first day is a set-apart gathering, and on the seventh day you have a set-apart gathering. No work at all is done on them, only that which is eaten by every being, that alone is prepared by you.

We need to clear up some misconceptions about the first and 7<sup>th</sup> day of this appointed time. The words highlighted above are Qodesh Miqra (set apart gathering) and Mela kah (work). It has been given to understand these are "High Sabbaths". Sabbath does not appear anywhere in this verse. It is similar to a Shabbat in that you may not work at your employment for money on these days. Nor can you make anyone else work on these days. If you have a prepaid pass and can get into a place without having money changing hands that is permissible. It is not permissible on the Shabbat. What does Qodesh Miqra (set apart gathering) mean? Qodesh does mean set apart. That is, Set apart to Yahuah. What is set apart? A Miqra. What is a Miqra? A calling together of an assembly for reading and reciting. Does this meeting last all day? No. So we are to set up a gathering that it's sole purpose is to read and recite regarding Yahuah. The rest of the day is not set apart to Yahuah like the Shabbat is. Just this meeting. So to be clear..

And you will guard, TN- as a strong covenant mark, this day, throughout your generations, as an unending statute, reenactment, custom.



Exod 12:18 'In the first *month*, on the fourteenth day of the month, at even, you will eat unleavened bread until the twenty-first day of the month at even.

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Yahuah just said that anyone eating leavened bread during this 7 day period needs to stay away- be separated from the Children of Yah'shar'al!

That means no socializing with people who are eating leavened bread! This includes close contact like someone cutting your hair. It is fine to shop and get gas, but do not have people in your house or you go into their house if they are eating leavened bread.





Do no go out to eat where they serve leavened bread even if you order just ice cream. The people were taken out of all close social influence in the Exodus.

The only exception is, if you have to work during these middle 5 days and it is not in your duties to be around leavened food. A co-worker eating it is ok but distance yourself from it. It is preferable to not work the whole week of unleavened bread but if you have to it is ok. Unless you work in a restaurant or place that serves leavened bread where you come into contact with it, then you should make plans to take this week off as vacation.







It would appear to us that the one word we really need to understand to the fullest extent and put into practice is Shamar- to guard. It shows up everywhere. If we fall into complacency with having done this feast so many

times we loose our edge, we will miss something important. We will have let our guard down.

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This feast of unleavened bread and Passover are not like any other feast where all are invited. You must pass some criteria which Yahuah has painstakingly laid out. This is Yahuah seeing if we are paying attention to His voice and be willing to do as He asks. Hopefully one understands how special this is. The door is narrow, and few find it. There is a "dress code" (being called by Yahuah and be in compliance) or you will not be allowed to enter.



Exod 12:44 but any servant, (an employee who lives in your house) a man has bought for silver, when you have circumcised him, **n**- as a strong covenant mark, he may eat of it.

21. When we trust Yahuah with our everything, we give to Him the highest praise we can give Him.



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

The same things utternd in Hebrew, and translated into another longue, have not the same face in them : and not only these things, but the law itself, and the prophene, and the rest of the books, have no small difference when they are spaces in their own languary.
