Our Methodology

The tricky thing about going chronological is that we get hints of an instruction way before it was written down in Exodus. This was a great eye opener as we went through Genesis. They knew of these things from somewhere. Adam and Hawah must have taught their children and now that the 365 books of Enoch are lost, we do not have an accurate picture of the first mention of these things.

We have chosen to deal with this by acknowledging the first mention of a subject but will not address it fully until the actual instruction is given. We want to recreate the feeling of starting from scratch. It seems to us that Yahuah watched mankind and as we progressed kept note of the things which caused us to stumble the most. It was then at Sinai that Yahuah was able to set in stone the things for us to guard against and remember that would keep us on the path. But we will see that the moral code was already in practice as well as some ceremonial things. How could it be otherwise? 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




An infographic posted on the United Church of Christ's Facebook page provides believers with "10 Ways You Can Actively Reject Your White Privilege."


> All are under the same Covenant. What is interesting is the language He uses. Promise to Yac'cob and inform the Children of Yah'shara'al.




Torah: Hebrew: תורה means "teaching, doctrine or instruction"



Did you notice that Mosha understood he was to speak to the ELDERS what Yahuah had said, and not gather every person together to speak the words of Yahuah this time? So in this context Yahuah wanted the ELDERS to know they would be responsible for teaching and keeping the people on the path. The people will have the responsibility to walk the path and by their actions, influence others by showing the righteous standard by which to live. If the Elders (teachers) get it wrong, the people get it wrong. Here is a perfect example what a bad interpretation of what Yahuah said.



It may be shocking to you that this is just the opposite of what Yahuah said. You see Context matters. He was upset with how the teachers were teaching. This is taken from Isaiah 28:10. What did He say 1-9 and 11-15? The context is priests and prophets- those who descended from these Elders of Exodus 19 some who are now in Ephraim have really messed up. They went the way of the world. Yahuah is not happy and here is whypicking up in verse 7.. Isaiah 28:7 And these too have gone astray through wine, and through strong drink wandered about. Priest and prophet have gone astray through strong drink, they are swallowed up by wine, they wander about through strong drink, they go astray in vision, they stumble in right ruling.

Isaiah 28:8 For all tables shall be covered with vomit, no place without filth. Isaiah 28:9 Whom would He teach knowledge? And whom would He make to understand the message? Those weaned from milk, those taken from the breasts!

Isaiah 28:10 For it is: command upon command, command upon command, line upon line, line upon line, here a little, there a little.



Wow, Yahuah is condemning them for doing this, yet most teachers today teach that this is how you are to form a study!

A person's head contains his highest and most vital faculties — the mind and the sensing organs, as well as the inlets for food, water and oxygen — but it is the neck that joins the head to the body and channels the flow of consciousness and vitality from the one to the other: the head heads the body via the neck.

..we must first examine the nature of weeping in general. What do tears actually achieve? Tears give vent to the feelings of distress and frustration that accompany the knowledge that something is not as it should be. After a "good cry," a person is somewhat relieved of these feelings, although the situation that prompted his tears remains unchanged. Is this a positive phenomenon? At first glance, it would seem not. Distress and frustration are what drive a person to rectify the negative reality that gave rise to them. To lessen them by other means would seem to counteract their purpose and utility.

But what if one has done all there is to be done? In such a case, where weeping cannot be faulted for reducing the impetus for action, one can point to its constructive uses. It may serve to communicate one's empathy with a fellow's troubles. And it may serve to alert others to the gravity of the situation — others who are in a position to do something about it.

Citing the verse (Isaiah 52:2), "Shake yourself from the dust ... O Jerusalem," the Midrash expounds, "As a rooster who shakes off the dust from his wings." Our sages explain: when a rooster has wallowed in the dust, a thousand people with a thousand combs cannot clean it; but with a single vigorous shake, the rooster can free himself of every last speck of dust. One can educate, inspire, drive and otherwise assist another to develop and improve himself; ultimately, however, the only one who can effect any real and lasting change is the person himself. https://www.chabad.org/parshah/article_cdo/aid/3222/jewish/The-Neck.htm





- Gen 9:12 And Eternal said, "This is the sign of the covenant which I make between Me and you, and every living creature that is with you, for all generations to come: 13 "I shall set My rainbow in the cloud, and it shall be for the sign of the covenant between Me and the earth. 14 "And it shall be, when I bring a cloud over the earth, that the rainbow shall be seen in the cloud, 15 and I shall remember My covenant which is between Me and you and every living creature of all flesh, and never again let the waters become a flood to destroy all flesh. 16 "And the rainbow shall be in the cloud, and I shall see it, to remember the everlasting covenant between Eternal and every living creature of all flesh that is on the earth." 17 And Eternal said to Noah, "This is the sign of the covenant which I have established between Me and all flesh that is on the earth."
- Gen 17:8 "And I will give to you and your offspring after you R as a strong covenant mark the ground of your pilgrimage R as a strong covenant mark, all the ground of Kena'an's property for an indeterminate and unending time going on into the future. And I shall be their Eternal."



- Gen 17:11 "And you will circumcise **¬№** as a strong covenant mark the flesh of your foreskin, and it will come to exist as a sign of the Covenant between Me and you.
- Exod 3:15 And Eternal said further to Mosheh, "Thus you are to say to the children of Yah'shara'al, ' יהוה' Eternal of your fathers, the Eternal of Abraham, the Eternal of Yah'shaq, and the Eternal of Ya'cob, has sent me to you. Gen 13:14"Now lift up your eyes (Abram) and look from the place where you are, northward and southward and eastward and westward, 15 for all the land which you see I shall give to you and your seed forever. 16 "And I shall make your seed as the dust of the earth, so that, if a man could count the dust of the earth, then your seed also could be counted. 17 "Arise, walk in the land through its length and its width, for I give it to you."

And I will exist with you and kneel down and bless you, because I give TN as a strong covenant mark, all these countries to you and your offspring. And I shall establish and confirm TN as a strong covenant mark, the Covenant oath which I swore to Abraham your father.
- Exod 6:1 And said יהוה to Mosheh, "Now you will see what I do to Pharaoh. Because with a hand wielding the force of authority, he will send them out, and with a hand wielding the force of authority, he is going to drive them away of his land."
- Exod 6:6 "Therefore, say to the children of Yah'shara'al, 'I am יהוה , and I will bring, אמ as a strong covenant mark, you out from under the forced labor of the Mitsrites, and shall deliver, rescue and defend, את as a strong covenant mark, you from their bondage, and shall redeem (reclaim as My own) as a strong covenant mark, you with an arm extended and spread out, and with a large number of unusual punishments, causing surprise and astonishment.
