





On these two instructions Hang all the Torah and the Prophets."



The tricky thing about going chronological is that we get hints of an instruction way before it was written down in Exodus. This will be a great eye opener as we go through Genesis. They knew of these things from somewhere. Adam and Hawah must have taught their children and now that the 365 books of Enoch are lost, we do not have an accurate picture of the first mention of these things.

We have chosen to deal with this by acknowledging the first mention of a subject but will not address it fully until the actual instruction is given. We want to recreate the feeling of starting from scratch. It seems to us that Yahuah watched mankind and as we progressed kept note of the things which caused us to stumble the most. It was then at Sinai that Yahuah was able to set in stone the things for us to guard against and remember that would keep us on the path. But we will see that the moral code was already in practice as well as some ceremonial things. How could it be otherwise? Everyone has had the information they needed to come to love and choose Yahuah, if He has chosen them. There are some things that prevent Him from choosing certain creations, so let us keep that in mind, even if we do not fully understand it. Gen 15:7 And He said to him, "I am יהוה , who brought you out of Ur of the Chaldeans, to give you this land to inherit it."

> Yahuah is telling Abram the reason He brought him there. There was a much bigger purpose than just to re-locate him and his family.



Gen 15:8 And he asked, "Ale Shaddai הוה", how will I know that I will have ownership of it ?"

This is a common question we all ask when the promise is so big and beyond our control. For example, how do we know that we are pleasing Yahuah? If He has called us, we can be reasonably sure it is because He has confidence that we can endure to the end. But how do we know that we will have ownership in the promise of eternal life? Yahuah, sensing that Abram needed a more tangible commitment, performed a most godesh covenant ceremony. Yahuah also knowing that we too needed something more concrete to hold on to, to remind of His promise- gave Moshe the Torahthat gives directions to the path home and how to please Him.

Gen 15:9 And He said to him, "Collect for Me a three-year-old heifer, and a three-year-old female goat, and a three-year-old ram, and a turtledove, and a young eagle."





Abraham's Sacrifice of a Heifer Three Years Old, of a Goat, and of a Ram Also Three Years Old: Its Meaning; Every Age to be Consecrated

Now, he who watches over and restrains himself in part, and in part is distracted and wandering, is not wholly given up to Yahuah. Hence it is necessary that the perfect man offer up all, both the things of the soul and those of the flesh, so that he may be complete and not lacking. Therefore also Yahuah instructs Abram, "Take Me an heifer of three years old, and a she goat of three years old, and a ram of three years old, and a turtle dove, and a young eagle;" which is admirably said; for remark, that concerning those things, He also gives this command, Bring them Me and keep them free from the yoke, even your soul uninjured, like a heifer, and your flesh, and your reason; the last like a goat, since he traverses lofty and precipitous places, and the other like a ram, that he may in nowise skip away, and fall and slip off from the right way. For thus will you be perfect and blameless, O Abraham, when you have offered to Me your soul, and your sense, and your mind, which He mentioned under the symbol of the heifer, the goat, and the ram of three years old.

"Though this difference is to be observed, that the Levitical law required creatures of a year old only to be offered; whereas these were three years old, because they are then at their full growth, and in their full strength and greatest perfection.



But it should be remarked, that these creatures here were not taken merely for sacrifice, nor is there any mention made of their being offered; though it is probable they might be offered after they had answered the principal end, which was to be a sign, whereby Abram might know that his offspring should inherit the land. But the intention of Yahuah was, that as by them, Abram's offspring might be taught what sort of creatures they were to offer for their sins, so chiefly to show that they themselves would fall a sacrifice to the rage and fury of their enemies, in a land not theirs, and be used as these creatures were.

The number three may denote the three complete centuries in which they would be afflicted, and in the fourth come out safe and whole like the undivided birds, the turtle dove, and eagle, to which they were comparable."

It is not consistent with Yahuah's Character as The Creator of all things that He would ever require the destruction of the very life He created in order to show loyalty to Him. Gill is correct, at this point, this is to show the consequences of breaking the Covenant with Him. The Covenantal relationship we have with Him must have a standard. There was no Torah written down, but in selecting These animals the basis of the Torah was outlined.



 The unyoked 3 year old heifer: He is saying that with free will (unyoked) they were to make this pledge to Him with their whole soul, at the age of accountability (3 years for a Heifer).

The 3 year old Goat: they will pledge to reason their steps in the sure footedness in trust of Yahuah's guidance no matter the width of the ledge, knowing they are safe. The wild goats like to live in higher elevations. They are very social creatures and are content with their home range when domesticated. Dayenue- to know when to say "what you have done for me Yahuah through your plan is enough for me."

The Three year old ram: A steadfastness to stay on the path and not be lured away. A fierce guarding of his turf- the road Yahuah is guiding us on. Rams often settle arguments with fights that include ramming their heads into others. Not afraid of conflict but also not afraid to "use their heads" when dealing with conflict. They have good judgement due to their very good eyesight which helps them accurately judge distances when jumping. All of these attributes Yahuah sums up with the word SHAMAR! Guard my instructions!

You can see all of this spelled out in Deuteronomy and the actual giving of the instructions. It is like these are the living pictographs and the Torah is the actual written out words.



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These animals signify the qualities Abram's offspring would agree to become like in relationship to Yahuah. Remember there was already the penalty of death laid upon mankind for the garden debacle. 14

I. **TITLE DOVE** (an onomatopoetic and primitive word), Gen. 15:9; Levit. 12:6; used as a word of endearment for a beloved female, Cant. 2:12 [?]; used of the people of Israel; Ps. 74:19, **TIP** "thy turtle dove," i. e. the people especially dear to thee, now afflicted and timid.

Turtledove Love



The turtledove represents the people of the 12 tribes of Ishrael to come- the offspring of Abram. This represents the promise that Abrams offspring on the 12 tribes side would be beloved and they would endure. Note if you will, the 12 feather expanse on the bottom. The symbolism is breathtaking. The baby eagle represented the offspring to come from the 12 tribes of Ishrael. There is much promised to them as well.

Isaiah 40:30 says "They that wait upon Yahuah will renew their strength, they will mount up with wings as eagles, they will run and not be weary, and they will walk and not faint."



Each day an eagle will stare into the "sun" for as much as 45 minutes while tears pour from their eyes to cleanse them. In comparison, as we gaze into Torah to observe the esteem of Yahuah it too will cleanse us within while our tears flow. Every day an eagle will clean each feather by pulling it through its beak. This is called preening to clean and oil itself and to prepare for the day as it stares into the sun. A reminder of our need to prepare ourselves before we go before the Father.

The young are very ugly at birth with no feathers. Our Heavenly Father knows we are vulnerable and is patient with us to grow our trust strong in Him so that we will be able to soar and endure.

The eagle can dive straight down at a speed of 180 miles per hour to catch its prey or to bear up its young with wings when teaching them to fly. What a lesson when all hope is gone and we have fallen from His favor and disappointed Him.

Sometimes in life, eagles have been known to seem depressed, and live for a time in the low, dark areas of the rocks below the mountains. They will not search for food or clean themselves. Their oil glands gum up and they cannot fly, and they eventually die. But, the strong eagles will fly down and drop meat for them until they clean themselves, are strong, and can fly again. No one knows why this sometimes happens. We must be vigilant to keep watch over Yahuah's Covenant family and be aware if they need help.

Isn't amazing how Yahuah uses animal characteristics to get important messages across to us?



The covenant is unbreakable because the ritual "seals the deal" and henceforth cannot be broken except on pain of death of the one who provided the animals (normally the beneficiary):



#1. Who provided the animals?

Most would say Abram but that is not true. He collected them for Yahuah. Yahuah provided the animals in Genesis 1:1.

#2. What was the purpose of this ritual?

To prove to Abram that Yahuah would be true to His word about him obtaining ownership of the land at first and then Yah added more details later.

#3. So who, upon breaking this covenant would be expected to die or cease to exist?

YAHUAH!

Since Yahuah can never cease to exist, then it was a magnificent gesture for Yahuah to tell Abram He would take that judgement if He failed ^{12/21} Abram!. It was like saying, Abram! You can take this to the bank! Gen 15:11 And the birds of prey came down on the carcasses, and **¬**★ (as a strong covenant mark), Abram drove them away.

So for Abram's part, he was to teach the attributes to his offspring and chase away the birds of prey. In this living pictograph, who are the birds of prey? It would be the adversary, trying to "eat away" at the qualities of the heifer, goat and ram, till there is noting left but empty shells of people who no longer have a a relationship with Yahuah.

So Abram had from Yahuah a covenant that promised that Yahuah had a plan to give Abram the land and that his offspring would beloved. This is because they would be instructed how to live in Yahuah's integrity and righteousness.

Yahuah is binding Himself to the promise to give Abram an heir, descendants, land—and a redeemer - (remember the turtledove and eaglet). Gen 15:12 And it came to be, when the sun was going down, that a deep sleep fell upon Abram, and behold, an unusually thick darkness fell upon him.

Yahuah was being brutally honest with Abram. But it also explains why Abram needed to teach Yahuah's integrity to his offspring! They were going to fail the test, but they were not going to loose the war. Yahuah didn't have to warn Abram. This would happen way after he died. But with this omen over their heads that Abram also passed along to his offspring as a warning, there would be enough people for Yahuah to fulfil this promise in the Exodus Extravaganza. He is also saying, 'Abram , don't expect this to be fulfilled in your lifetime, but trust me it will be a beautiful thing once it is all said and done'.

It is one thing for Yahuah to put His children in time out, but if you abuse them, then you answer to Him. And when you are on the receiving end of Yahuah's Judgement, you will either harden your heart or repent and come like the mix multitude and see the error of your ways. Using this as a future teaching moment for both parties is the genius of Yahuah. You either seal your fate or you unseal the way to eternal shalom with the Father.

In our living pictograph vison here we see that this Covenant was undertaken by two represented items. The first a smoking furnace.

> It wasn't an actual furnace but best described as a containment of fire and smoke. (Where there is smoke there is fire). It went through first. It was bigger. It was the source of the fire that was on the firebrand behind it. It represented Yahuah the Father.

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The second is the firebrand- brilliant and agile. Having been lit from the burning smoking furnace - the fire essence is exactly the same but in a diminished quantity. It is in unity of purpose with the smoking furnace, agreeing to the same Covenant. That if for some reason, this promise was not kept, the firebrand would cease to exist. The firebrand is Yahusha, son of the Eternal Almighty Yahuah. It was here that Yahusha publicly proclaimed his role in Yahuah's plan of redemption for the turtledove (the 12 tribes of Ishrael) and the eaglet - her offspring- those that would become Children of the Covenant of Yahuah.



It would be on his shoulders to execute the redemption process and if he failed, he would pay the price for both he and Yahuah. This is where it gets tricky, stay with us. In order to fulfil the promise fully, Yahusha needed to take away the penalty of death that was still on the judgement books. Not evident here, but when you skip ahead in the story, you find the only way to do that is for the penalty of death to be paid. Yahusha took on the sins of the world as his own. He was then judged the death sentence by His father.

Here is the amazing part that most miss. It was by Yahusha's death that the promise by the firebrand was fulfilled. He did not die because the he and Yahuah somehow broke the promise, this was the promise. Now if Yahusha had gotten cold feet in the Garden of Gethsemane or took shatan up on his offer when he tempted him, then when Yahusha died a mortal death he would have stayed dead! Because he could not then redeem the turtledove or eaglet, and by breaking that promise he agreed to cease to exist



Let that sink in!

21. When we trust Yahuah with our everything, we give to Him the highest praise we can give Him.




