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
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

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
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A Slight Detour- Understanding Honor and Shame

Isa 55:9 "For as the heavens are higher than the earth, so are My ways higher than your ways, and My thoughts than your thoughts.

In the first three parts we put Yahuah's words in context and got to unlock more insight on Honor and Shame. As always, Yahuah is teaching us that when we follow His path, then we will be given everything we need. Do we trust Him?

Isa 55:1 "Oh everyone who thirsts, come to the waters. And you who have no silver, come, separate into small portions and eat. Come, separate into small portions the wine and milk without silver and without price.



As we separated Yahuah's word into smaller pieces - We found clearly how Yahuah nourishes His children and His expectations for us to stay "under His tent". Do we trust His word?





When Yahuah calls the thirsty ones to come to the water, it is the cleansing, transformative, living water. The Torah.

Remember- Everyone is thirsty! Yahuah calls all- It is those who respond that can take part in the expectation of Yahuah's blessings.

We reviewed the word Shama. Strong's H8085 and found the pattern in the Pictograph, water and nourishment. Nothing with Yahuah is a coincidence- It is a PATTERN. We revisited our Greek vs Hebrew thinking. Internalizing our walk with Yahuah - (belief) vs externalizing our walk (trust).

Now we understand that as we (those who have answered the call and have acted upon the requirements) have an expectation of Yahuah to fulfill His promises, He has an expectation we will outwardly respond to His word and be slowly transformed into people, that He wants to live with for Eternity. We must learn to convert our shame into honor and Yahuah has lovingly given us patterns of how to recognize which state we are in and how to restore our relationships.





"so is My Word that goes forth from My mouth – it does not return to Me empty, but shall do what I please, and shall certainly accomplish what I sent it for. (Isaiah 55:11).

To find favor, pity or mercy from Yahuah is the reaction on His part that brings us back into honor with Him. It's The Power of Yahuah's Words that bring changes. Never underestimate the power of Yahuah's Word to change a person's life, to change your life when nothing else can or will. Yahuah called us all when we were not worthy of this mercy. That is how much He loves us. We now have to work on ourselves to stay in that state of Honor by His standards.

We must trust Yahuah. We ask for guidance and wisdom in reverence and appreciation that we are even allowed to speak to the Creator of the Universe and beyond. Then the Ruach can perform the miracle of keeping us on track while being joyful, patient, fearless and trusting that either Yahuah has caused our surroundings or is allowing it for a more beneficial outcome for His children with whom He is in Covenant with.

People react to celebrities who have no power to change or extend their lives with such an outpouring of affection, but by the same token, blame Yahuah at the drop of a hat when things are going south. We need to be careful to not disrespect Yahuah by forgetting our place in HIS WORLD.






The Hebrew word for TRUST is Em-u-nah. It is defined as:




- A foundational pillar of strength and support



Let us confirm this by Revelation ISR Version

Rev 2:7 "He who has an ear, let him hear what the Spirit says to the assemblies. To him who overcomes I shall give to eat from the tree of life, which is in the midst of the Paradise of Yahuah." 2:8 "And to thethe assembly in Smyrna write, '... 2:9 "I know your works, and pressure, and poverty – yet you are rich – and the blasphemy of those who say they are Yehudim and are not, but are a congregation of Satan. 2:10 "Do not be afraid of what you are about to suffer. See, the devil is about to throw some of you into prison, in order to try you, and you shall have pressure ten days. 




What is Shame?

- A painful feeling of humiliation or distress caused by the consciousness of wrong or foolish behavior
- A loss of respect or esteem; dishonor

A painful sensation excited by a consciousness of guilt, or of having done something which injures reputation; or by of that which nature or modesty prompts us to conceal. *Shame* is particularly excited by the disclosure of actions which, in the view of men, are mean and degrading. Hence it it is often or always manifested by a downcast look or by blushes, called *confusion of face*.

Yahuah's New System for Status

Both in the Old Testament and in honor-shame cultures today, Yahuah intends to play the role often played by the social group and to form a new social group that revolves around Him. Yahuah initiates relationships with human beings where He is, in the idiom of many honor-shame cultures, the patron or big man. Yahuah takes care of us, and we belong to Him. He takes care of us in a way that is profoundly counter-cultural to honor-shame cultures. He makes His relationship with us more important than His own honor in the eyes of those who don't follow Him. We see this when Yahuah allows Himself to be shamed in the eyes of the nations because Jerusalem has fallen (Ezek 36:20). He even promises a Savior who will be shamed for His people (Isa 50:6).



When the honor-shame system revolves around Yahuah, He decides what results in honor and shame and His followers encourage each other to stay on His path. Yahuah states clearly that it is impossible to have honor before Him without following Him and honoring Him (1Sam 2:30). Furthermore, those who trust idols will be shamed (Psa 97:7) and those who oppress the poor insult Yahuah (Prov 14:31). These offenses matter because failure to follow Yahuah's instructions results in consequenses and shame (Ezek 5:7-8; Ezr 9:7). In Yahuah's system of status, He often blesses His people with a certain amount of power and wealth (Prov 22:4; 1 Chr 29:12)—and thus honor before other people—that should be used to serve Him. It is possible, however, that Yahuah will call on His people to bear shame before others for His sake (Psa 42:3; Acts 5:40-41).

The highest status for people lies in receiving the honor that Yahuah gives them because they are His (Psa 22:6; Psa 91:14-15). Yahuah's people find hope in the fact that He saves those who are weak and have been dishonored and gives them honor (Zeph 3:19). Yahuah Himself deserves honor because He is powerful and wealthy but—even more importantly—because He is faithful to His people even to the point of sending His Son to bear their sin and shame (Heb 12:2) and to give them honor as a gift. (If they commit to Him).



In Proverbs, the carrot of honor appears larger than the stick of shame. Acquiring honor is a legitimate motivator in biblical ethics. **Yahuah** wants people to have honor (aka, a good name, a crown, praise, etc.).

A Good Name- Proverbs

Let love and faithfulness never leave you...Then you will win favor and a good name in the sight of Yahuah and man. (3:3-4)

The **name** of the righteous is used in **blessings**, but the **name** of the wicked will rot. (10:7)

A **good name** is more **desirable** than **great riches**; to be **esteemed** is better than silver or gold. (22:1)

Better to be a **nobody** and yet have a servant than **pretend to be somebody** and have no food. (12:9)



Yahuah mocks **proud** mockers but shows favor to the **humble** and **oppressed**. The wise inherit **honor**, but fools get only **shame**. (3:34-35)

When pride comes, then comes disgrace, but with humility comes wisdom. (11:2)

Pride goes before destruction, a haughty spirit before a fall. Better to be lowly in spirit along with the oppressed than to share plunder with the proud. (16:18-19; cf. 18:12)
Haughty eyes and a proud heart—the unplowed field of the

Do not put yourself forward in the **king's** presence or stand in the place of the **great**; for it is better to be told, "**Come up** here," than to be **put lower** in the presence of a noble. (25:6:7)

wicked—produce sin. (21:4)

A person's **pride** will bring **humiliation**, but one who is **lowly** in spirit will obtain **honor**. (29:23)

It is not good to eat much honey, or to seek **honor** on top of **honor**. (25:27)

A person is **praised** according to their prudence, and one with a warped mind is **despised**. (12:8)

He who ignores discipline comes to poverty and **shame**, but whoever heeds correction is **honored**. (13:18)

Righteousness exalts a nation, but sin is a disgrace to any people. (14:34)

Wisdom's instruction is to revere Yahuah, and humility comes before honor. (15:33)

A person's wisdom yields patience; it is to one's **glory** to overlook an **offense**. (19:11)

It is to one's **honor** to avoid strife, but every fool is quick to quarrel. (20:3)

Whoever pursues righteousness and love finds life, prosperity and honor. (21:21; cf. 22:4)

Do you see those who are skillful in their work? They will serve **kings**; they will not serve **common people**. (22:29)

Anyone who tends a fig tree will eat its fruit, and anyone who takes care of a master will be honored. (27:18)

Proverbs- A Fool's Shame

To answer before listening—that is folly and **shame**. (18:13)
Argue your case with your neighbor directly, and do not disclose another's secret; or else someone who hears you will bring **shame** upon you, and your **ill repute** will have no end. (25:9-10)

Like snow in summer or rain in harvest, so **honor** is not fitting for a fool. (26:1)

It is like binding a stone in a sling to give **honor** to a fool. (26:8) Whoever disregards discipline comes to poverty and **shame**, but whoever heeds correction is **honored**. (13:8)

The righteous hate what is false, but the wicked make themselves **a stench** and bring **shame** on themselves. (13:5) When wickedness comes, so does **contempt**, and with **shame** comes **disgrace**. (18:3)

Blows and **disgrace** are an adulterous man's lot, and his **shame** will never be wiped away. (6:33)

A king delights in a wise servant, but a **shameful** servant arouses his fury. (14:35)

Let us take a look as some of Yahusha's parables. He is talking about what the reign or kingdom of heaven is like. In Matthew 20, he talks about a vineyard owner who has to get workmen for the day. He picks the first crew early in the am and they agreed to a piece of silver for their work. He goes back at the 3rd, 6th, 9th and 11th hr picking up more workers who were standing idle- (no one would hire them) and he picked them as well. At the end of the day he called all the workers to pay them their wages beginning with the last to the 1st. Everyone got the same. 1 piece of silver.

Mat 20:10 "And when the first came, they thought they would receive more. But they too received each a silver piece. 20:11 "And when they received it, they grumbled against the vineyard owner, 20:12 saying, 'These last have worked only one hour, and you made them equal to us who have borne the burden and the heat of the day.' 20:13 "But he answering, said to one of them, 'Friend, I do you no wrong. Did you not agree with me for a silver piece? (did I not promise you everlasting life?) 20:14 'Take yours and go. But I wish to give to this last man as also to you. (Yahuah shows no partiality in men- all colors, all backgrounds, all genders, if they answer the call and do the work). 20:15 'Is it not right for me to do what I wish with my own? Or is your eye evil because I am good?' 20:16 "Thus the last shall be first, and the first last. For many are called, but few chosen." Attitude is everything.

Maybe those that came at the end of the day were fresh and had the strength to help get all the work done. Did those who were there all day benefit from more people working? Hmmm just asking for a friend.

Then Yahusha gives them the wedding parable. A king has made a wedding feast for his son and all the ones that were invited He sent his servants by to call them, would not come. Yikes! So he sent other servants to the ones who were invited- hey its going to be great- the dinner is ready come now. But they disregarded them and went back to work and worse yet the other invited ones grabbed His servants and insulted and killed them. Understandably the king was furious and sent His soldiers and destroyed the murders and set their city on fire. (Jerusalem 70 AD?). The King said - these people are not worthy to come who first received the invitation, now go out into the streets and anyone who wants to come as many as you can find, invite them to the wedding feast.. (that would be anyone who wants to be a Covenant family member.)

Mat 22:10 "And those servants went out into the street corners and gathered all whom they found, both wicked and good. And the wedding hall was filled with guests. 22:11 "And when the sovereign came in to view the guests, he saw there a man who had not put on a wedding garment, 22:12 and he said to him, 'Friend, how did you come in here not having a wedding garment?' And he was speechless. 22:13 "Then the sovereign said to the servants, 'Bind him hand and foot, take him away, and throw him out into the outer darkness – there shall be weeping and gnashing of teeth.'

Mat 22:14 "For many are called, but few are chosen."

Being disrespectful will not be tolerated in Yahuah's house. We are being given an amazing opportunity but even if we answer the call, if we just show up with not the attire required (honorable) we will be rejected. Think Cain and Abel.

Same pattern. Bad attitude.

Luke 18:1 And He spoke a parable to them, that they should always pray and not lose heart, 18:2 saying, "In a certain city there was a certain judge, not fearing Yahuah nor regarding man. 18:3 "And a widow was in that city, and she came to him, saying, 'Do right to me on my adversary.' 18:4 "And he would not for a while, but afterward he said within himself, 'Even if I do not fear Yahuah nor regard man, 18:5 yet because this widow troubles me I shall do right to her, lest by her continual coming she wears me out.'" 18:6 And Yahusha said, "Hear what the unrighteous judge said. 18:7 "And shall Yahuah not do right by all means to His own chosen ones who are crying out day and night to Him, and being patient over them?

Luk 18:8 "I say to you that He shall do right to them speedily. But when the Son of Adam comes, shall He find TRUST on the earth?"



Luk 22:28 "But you are those who have remained with Me in My trials. 22:29 "And I covenant for you, as My Father covenanted for Me, a reign, 22:30 to eat and drink at My table, in My reign, and to sit on thrones, judging the twelve tribes of Yah'shara'al." 22:31 And Yahusha said, "Shim'on, Shim'on! See, Satan has asked for you to sift you as wheat. 22:32 "But I have prayed for you, that your TRUST should not fail. And when you have returned, strengthen your brothers."

The adversary has a job to do, that Yahuah uses for our good. After Kepha was humbled, he was a much stronger foundation stone for the people than before when his ego was always flaring up. Quite the opposite of Paul.



We will close this out by looking at Revelation and the warnings and what to look out for. Patterns!

Rev 2:1 ... "To the assembly of Ephesus write,... 2:2 "I know your works, and your labor, and your endurance, and that you are not able to bear evil ones, and have tried those who say they are emissaries and are not, and have found them false; 2:3 and you have been bearing up and have endurance, and have labored for My Name's sake and have not become weary. 2:4 "But I hold this against you, that you have left your first love. 2:5 "So remember from where you have fallen, and repent and do the first works, or else I shall come to you speedily and remove your lampstand from its place, unless you repent.

These guys get it but they have forgotten Yahuah. To the Jews who never say His name but mostly follow Torah. Unfortunately the Talmud overrides it. Not good. To the Christians who get Yahusha and why he came but again are forgetting Yahuah and the whole Torah. They have replaced Jesus over Yahuah. They are great with charity still not going to cut it. None of these groups are properly dressed.

Rev 2:12 "And to the assembly in Pergamos write, 2:13 "I know your works, and 37 where you dwell, where the throne of Satan is. And you hold fast to my name/authority, and did not deny the trust in me, even in the days in which Antipas was my trustworthy witness, who was killed near you, where Satan dwells. 2:14 "But I hold a few *matters* against you, because you have there those who adhere to the teaching of Bil'am, who taught Balaq to put a stumbling-block before the children of Yah'shra'al, to eat *food* offered to idols, and to commit whoring. 2:15 "So you also have those who adhere to the teaching of the Nikolaites, which *teaching* I hate. 2:16 "Repent, or else I shall come to you speedily and fight against them with the sword of My mouth.

Rev 2:17 "He who has an ear, let him hear what the Spirit says to the assemblies. To him who overcomes I shall give some of the hidden manna to eat. And I shall give him a white stone, and on the stone a renewed Name written which no one knows except him who receives it."

Yahuah and Yahusha knows we are sometimes put right in the middle of evil to live, but there is still no excuse for not staying on the path. Why? Because we are protected. Do we fear man more than Yahuah? Yahusha will not spare those who water down their convictions to get along and not lose a job, or travel freely or .. Fill in the blank. Either we expect and trust to be protected or we don't. No fence sitting. Its either honor or shame.

Rev 2:18 "to ...the assembly in Thyatira write, '... 2:19 "I know your works, and 38" love, and service, and trust, and your endurance. And as for your works, the last are more than the first. 2:20 "But I hold against you that you allow that woman Jezebel, who calls herself a prophetess, to teach and lead My servants astray to commit whoring and to eat food offered to idols. 2:21 "And I gave her time to repent of her whoring, and she did not repent. 2:22 "See, I am throwing her into a bed of violent illness, and those who commit adultery with her into great affliction, unless they repent of their works. 2:23 "And I shall slay her children with death. And all the assemblies shall know that I am the One searching the kidneys and hearts. And I shall give to each one of you according to your works.

(1.) These wicked seducers were compared to Jezebel, and called by her name. Jezebel was a persecutor of the prophets of Yahuah, and a great patroness of idolaters and false prophets. The sin of these seducers was that they attempted to draw the servants of Yahuah into fornication, and to offer sacrifices to idols; they called themselves prophets, and so would claim a superior authority and regard to the ministers of the assembly. Two things aggravated the sin of these seducers, who, being one in their spirit and design, are spoken of as one person: - [1.] They made use of the name of Yahuah to oppose the truth of His doctrine and worship; this very much aggravated their sin. [2.] They abused the patience of Yahuah to harden themselves in their wickedness. Yahuah gave them space for repentance, but they repented not. Observe, repentance is necessary to prevent a sinner's ruin. Where Yahuah gives space for repentance, He expects fruits meet for repentance. Where the space for repentance is lost, the sinner perishes with a double destruction.

IT'S ALL WORTH IT!!! IF WE TRUST AND IF WE ARE TRUST WORTHY WE CAN HAVE THE EXPECTAION OF:

Rev 7:14 ... And he said to me, "These are those coming out of the great distress, having washed their robes and made them white in the blood of the Lamb. 7:15 "Because of this they are before the throne of Yahuah, and serve Him day and night in His Dwelling Place. And He who sits on the throne shall spread His Tent over them. 7:16 "They shall hunger no more, neither thirst any more, neither shall the sun strike them, nor any heat, 7:17 because the Lamb who is in the midst of the throne shall shepherd them and lead them to fountains of waters of life. And Yahuah shall wipe away every tear from their eves.








