Nehemia: And by the way, in Hebrew the word "nechoshet" can mean copper, bronze or brass. There's no distinct term for it. Meaning, it's all nechoshet. And bronze and brass are copper alloys, they're like, 90-something percent copper with some tint thrown in to strengthen it. What I was thinking is in verse 14, perhaps this is an allusion to Daniel 7. The only problem is, in Daniel 7 that describes the ancient of days, not the son of man. So, I don't know.

Nehemia is having some trouble wrapping his head around the fact that Yahusha is Yahuah's son. The Jewish religion does not recognize this. It is so obvious, that putting Daniel and Revelation side by side here, we see the son looking like his Father. That is not odd - it's confirmation. Daniel goes on to confirm the rest of Revelation 1:13-20. It also confirms Rev 1:7a (Yahuchanon quoting Scripture) Behold, he (Yahusha) comes with clouds; and all eyes will see him (Yahusha).

T-Bone: I'm trying to understand the polished copper glowing. Is that like molten copper, or...?

Nehemia: Well, when we say "polished copper" we're guessing. We don't really know what kalal means. It appears twice in the Tanakh, and one is something Ezekiel saw, one is something Daniel saw. So, we don't really know. It's some kind of copper. It could be actually molten copper. So here, what we have to do is, we've got to put an English word in there, and we don't want to say kalal "copper" so we say polished copper. But that's actually a guess from the context of Daniel and Ezekiel. It sounds to me like it's something that's glowing like white hot, or red hot, perhaps 22

T-Bone: What I find interesting is the double-edged sword portion of this- How that ties in with the word of Yehovah.

Nehemia: That phrase, "double-edged sword", is the phrase that appears in Psalms, and the word is "herev pifiyot", it's in Psalm 149 verse 6, and that is translated in the original King James. "Let the high praises of Yahuah be in their mouth and a two-edged sword in their hand." So, what exactly does that mean? And by the way, I've heard people say that "two-edged sword" means you get cut when you hold it. No, it's not a sword without a handle. It's a sword that, in fact, if you look at like a kitchen knife, one side's sharp and one side's dull. Well, the two-edged sword is sharp on both sides.. And of course, a sword presumably is larger than a dagger, more like perhaps a dirk. In any event, yeah, I don't know what the significance of that is. It's a good question.

AJ Bernard: So that our only weapon, our only offensive weapon is the word of our testimony. We preach the word of God, and that's how we overcome.

Nehemia: Okay. So, what's the significance of it being a double-edged sword versus a single-edged sword?

AJ Bernard: I'm not sure. I would think that it would go back to the military usage. If you're in a battle and you're fighting with a single-edged sword and your sword gets nicked, and chipped, and goes dull, you can always turn it around and use the other edge if you have another edge on there. So, it's a more powerful weapon than a simple, single-edged sword.

Nehemia: Okay. And I think in Psalms what it's saying is... let's go back to the Psalm 149:6, "Let the high praises of Yahuah be in their mouth and a two-edged sword in their hand," that the praises of God are this powerful weapon. I mean, a single-edged sword you can kill somebody. But the double-edged sword, that's the powerful weapon of war. And the high praises of God being in your mouth, and in your case in the New Testament, in the testimony, is this powerful weapon. And I guess that's the image here in Revelation - that he's got this powerful weapon in his hand, and I guess you could tie it into testimony. I don't know that we should read too much into it, but you could tie it into testimony and to praises of God.

The verse is talking about what is coming out of Yahusha's mouth not modern-day preachers. Let's think about this logically. Was the "new testament" written when Yahusha was first here? No. What came out of his mouth to defend, inspire and condemn? The words directly from Yahuah and quotes from the word of Yahuah from the Torah, Prophets and Writings, or Tanakh. Do we overcome by preaching to people? That isn't right. What does that have to do with the passage about what Yahusha? And it is not talking about a weapon in his hand.



# DOUBLE-EDGED SWORD



For the Word of Yahuah is quick, and powerful, and sharper than any two-edged sword, piercing even to the dividing asunder of soul and ruach, and of the joints and marrow, and is a discerner of the thoughts and intents of the heart.

Heb 4:13 Neither is there any creature that is not manifest in His sight: but all things are naked and opened to the eyes of Him with whom we have to give account.

Nehemia: "And when I saw Him, I fell to His feet like a dead person. And He put His 26 right hand on me and He said, 'Do not be afraid. I am the first and the last.'" AJ Bernard: The Aleph and the Tav.

(Notice AJ, because of his theology jumped to the conclusion that it said in Hebrew Aleph Tau. This is why looking at the words are so important. The Aramaic got it correct-even if we did not have this in Hebrew.)

Nehemia: Right. Well, here it says, "Ha rishon veha'acharon," the first and the last. AJ Bernard: Right., (AJ is still is not HEARING the words- his brain is still putting in Aleph Tau)

Nehemia: Yeah. But you're saying that's the significance of Aleph Tav. Could we talk about that for a minute? I know this is controversial.

Nehemia: So, when he says in verse 8, "I am the Aleph and the Tav," you're saying He means, "I'm the first and the last"? He doesn't mean that He's the word Aleph-Tav in the Hebrew language? I'm serious.

WHAO!!. Nehemia just referred back to verse 8 where YAHUAH was talking! He said He was the Aleph Tau. But they all are confusing the two here in verse 18. Clearly Yahusha is talking saying he is the first and last - NOT the Aleph Tau! First and Last and Aleph Tau do not refer to being Eternal! Aleph Tau is a sign of a Strong Covenant Mark. Yahusha can act as a strong covenant mark, but he is not Eternal, since he is a created being. He was not first. He did not create Yahuah. Yahuah could end his existence -So he is not last. Yahusha is first and last as in a uniquely created being. And Yahuah is The Aleph Tau- THE Strong Covenant Mark. Yahuah could not be the first and last because He is Eternal. He has always been, always will be. Let's review.

- 1. (Yahuchanon speaking): The revelation to Yahusha the Mashiyach, which Yahuah gave to him (Yahusha) to show to his (Yahusha's) servants the things that must shortly occur and by necessity be done with wrath: and he (Yahusha) signified and symbolized it to make clear, explain and notify, and which is consistently taught by Torah by sending it, through his (Yahusha's) messenger to his servant Yahuchannon;
- 2. Who (Yahuchanon- John) bore witness to the Word of Yahuah, and to the testimony and martyrdom of Yahusha the Mashiyach, as to all and whatever that he saw.
- 3. His (Yahuah's) blessings to the ones that are called that reads aloud, and those who hear the words of this prophecy, and guarding for themselves the things that are written in it; for the time is near.



Rev 1:8 "I am Aleph, also Taw," a Strong Covenant Mark, says the Master YHWH, Eternal; who is existing, and He who has always existed, and He who is coming, (Hayah Asher Hayah) the Omnipotent- unlimited power, authority and influence Al Shaddai- He who holds all.

AJ Bernard: [laughing] I've heard people try to make the argument that the Hebrew word "et" as in "Bereishit bara Elohim et hashamayim v'et ha'aretz," that that's referring to Yeshua as the "et". And the people who make that argument generally don't understand how Hebrew works. They want to say that this "et" is Moses putting the stamp of Yeshua's divinity on the Elohim of Bereishit 1. It's not. The "et" just shows which object receives the action of the verb.

AJ is half right here in my opinion. Question did Yahuah create words or anything for that matter not to be translated? When they used pictographs

that would be quite cumbersome to just chisel something to be ignored when if read in context it is not necessary. However, read this and insert "as a strong Covenant mark and it makes perfect sense.

One more feature of this verse will be inspected. The seven Hebrew words of Genesis 1:1 are written out in Figure 20. The numerical value of each of the words is denoted below the word, and remember that Hebrew reads from right to left.

The middle word, with a value of 401, is not translated. Some may say it is superfluous, but nothing could be further from the truth. The word consists of the first and the last letter of the Hebrew alphabet, the 'Aleph' and the 'Tav'. This middle word is Jesus, present and central in creation and as the Word, He is represented by the first and the last letter of the Hebrew alphabet!

Nehemia: My head is spinning. Putting the stamp of divinity...? I don't know even know what you're talking about. So, et has a grammatical function, and I had a guy write to me just this morning. He said, "Well, that word Aleph-Tav is never pronounced. It's actually unpronounceable." I'm like, when I was in first grade and we read, "Bereishis bara es hashamayim v'es ha'aretz," we read it with the Ashkenazic pronunciation. It has a vowel under the Aleph which makes it therefore pronounceable. It has a segel or a tzeirei, depending on whether it's connected to the word after it or not. They want to give it a spiritual meaning. And look, I can't tell you it doesn't have a spiritual meaning. I can just tell you what the grammatical meaning is. This is what I say – if you want to interpret it spiritually, that's got nothing to do with me and the text. But please, first understand what the literal grammatical function is, and if you don't understand that, then you're the tail wagging the dog.

AJ Bernard: Amen. We must deal in truth.

Question: Who made the grammar? Man Who made the vowel points? The Masorete's didn't invent the vowel system, they invented a series of graphic symbols to represent the vowels. When did they come to exist? When we open up a Hebrew Bible today, if you go online and you see a Bible and you see the vowel points, those are Tiberian points. Vowel and cantillation marks were added to the Bible between 8th and 9th century. At 135 AD 102 years after Yahusha left, the Dead Sea Scrolls had no grammar points. Did Yahuah teach Mosha grammar?


Nehemia: And I think you're doing yourself a disservice, because I hear people saying this. And more importantly, other Jews hear them and they say, "Well, so their whole faith is based on misconception of how Hebrew works, a misunderstanding. So, their faith must have nothing to it. It's just wrong." That's what normal Jews hear when they hear this Aleph-Tav being not the first and last, which is presumably what's meant, but rather being this grammatical "direct object marker" (which points to Jesus). But anyway, who am I to say? I mean, really, I can't tell somebody what they should believe - that's between them and the Creator of the Universe. What I can do is talk about grammar and texts.

The direct object marker (or dom) – Is a Hebrew word that indicates to the reader (or listener) that the following word is a direct object of a preceding verb. The dom is never translated.

Nehemia was kind of confusing here, but he is saying the Aleph Tau is pronounceable, it means first and last and it has a grammar function. To attribute this to directly pointing to Jesus is not what the Hebrew language indicates. I agree it does not point to "Jesus" or Yahusha and that it is pronounceable. But the grammar aspect was man made. It does not mean first and last. The Greek counter part of this would\_be the Alpha and Omega meaning the first and last. But we should not put a Greek concept on the Hebrew. Hayah Asher Hayah is not even close to meaning first and last. When it comes to Yahuah, He is Eternal, and this is how He describes Himself. See Exodus 3:14

Looking at the Hebrew pictographs, we will find that it is not a grammatical pointer but has word meanings like all Hebrew letters.








Now think about this. If the Aleph Tau was just grammatical and first and last, (which is not even a "Scholars" definition, then why is it in the Scriptures (according to them) 53 times? This is including all the different vowel pointing configuration.

That's impossible if it is pointing to a direct object in a sentence!
The reason lo-shema, the Jews and Christians don't want to call attention to it is because it points to the real Covenant, and they WANT to ignore it like it is not there!

Go back and read the Tanakh with the Aleph Tau notated and read it "as a strong Covenant mark" and you will be amazed. It points out the ones in evil covenants and all the things Yahuah sees as a mark of being in Covenant!

However amazing the Aleph Tau is, that should not even be the discussion! The first error both made was inserting Aleph Tau! Do you see an Aleph Tau there? It says, "Ha rishon veha'acharon," the first and the last. So, what is Yahusha saying? He is the first unique creature both human and divine Yahuah ever made, and he is the last one Yahuah will ever make. Then he goes on to describe his uniqueness. He is not "God"! Why? Because he lived and he died in human form. No matter what form Yahuah takes, He is ETERNAL, or we are all in a peck of trouble.

Nehemia: The "nails of death". And in the Greek it doesn't say "nails", in the Greek it says, "the keys of death and hades". Hades presumably is a Greek concept that's parallel to Sheol except obviously, it's somewhat different. This is probably the most significant difference from the Greek text." And I couldn't find any Greek text or even Aramaic. I couldn't find anybody who has anything other than "key", that has "nails".

Do you guys have any thoughts on these last two verses of chapter 1?

AJ Bernard: There's the issue of the angels of these churches, and does that refer to the divine heavenly beings, or does "angel" simply refer to messenger? Could it be the pastor or a prophetic figure?

Nehemia: And what is the word in Greek?

AJ Bernard: Angelos.

"This is the meaning of the mystery of the seven stars you saw in my right hand and the seven gold lampstands: The seven stars are the angels of the seven churches, and the seven lampstands are the seven churches."

Just thinking out loud here but a messenger is one bringing a message. A messenger would not be a person receiving the message. If he was just speaking to the the heads of the Called-Out Assembly, that's what he would have called them. The heads of the Assembly. But the stars were the angels ABOVE the assembly- watching out over them. Why does man always want to be a star?

Nehemia: So, "angelos" means "messenger", and it's just as ambiguous as Hebrew. In other words, in the Tanakh, "mal'ach" can be both a human or a spirit messenger, and there's no way to know except the context. And in Greek as well, "angelos" is just "messenger. Both Hebrew and Greek have this word that has this ambiguity. It's only from the context you could know whether it's angel or messenger.

AJ Bernard: Okay. And does that share the root with "melech" meaning "king?"

Nehemia: No, absolutely not. Melech, the root is Mem-Lamed-Khaf. The root of angel, "mal'ach," is Lamed-Aleph-Kaf. And "la'achah" means "to send, to send somebody to do something." So, mal'ach is "the one who is sent", that's the literal translation.





#### GEN 49:10-12

#### Lot of unbelievers: new heaven and new earth.

45:2 Neither will they ascend into heaven, nor will they reach the ground; such will be the lot of the sinners, who will deny the NAME of YAHUAH of Hosts, those who in this manner will be preserved for the day of burden and tribulation. 45:3 On that day, my Elect One shall sit on the seat of splendor and make a selection of their deeds, their resting places will be without number, their souls shall be firm within them when they see my Elect One, those who have appealed to my splendid name.

#### 46 HANOCH - ENOCH 46

#### The Son of Man, to whom belongs righteousness and with whom righteousness dwells

46:1 At that place, I saw the One to whom belongs the time before time. And his head was white like wool, and there was with him another individual, whose face was like that of a human being. His countenance was full of splendor like that of one among the kodesh malakim.

46:2 And I asked the one -from among the malakim -who was going with me. and who had revealed to me all the secrets regarding the One who was born of human beings, "Who is this, and from whence is he who is going as the

prototype of the Before -Time?"

46:3 And he answered me and said to me, "This is the Son of Man, to whom belongs righteousness, and with whom righteousness dwells. And he will open all the hidden storerooms; for YAHUAH of Hosts has chosen him, and he is destined to be victorious before YAHUAH of Hosts in eternal uprightness."

46:4 "This Son of Man whom you have seen is the One who would remove the kings and the mighty ones from their comfortable seats and the strong ones from their thrones. He shall loosen the reins of the strong and crush the teeth

of the sinners."

46:5 "He shall depose the kings from their thrones and kingdoms, for they do not extol and magnify him, and neither do they obey him, the source of their kingship."

46:6 "The faces of the strong will be slapped and be filled with shame and gloom. Their dwelling places and their beds will be worms. They shall have no hope to rise from their beds, for they do not extol the NAME of YAHUAH of Hosts."

46:7 "And they have become the judges of the stars of heaven; they raise their hands to reach YAHUAH the Most High while walking upon the earth and dwelling in her. They manifest all their deeds in oppression; all their deeds are oppression. Their power depends upon their wealth. And their devotion is to the gods which they have fashioned with their own hands. 46:8 "Yet they like to congregate in HIS houses and with the faithful ones who

#### The Son of Man: The Antecedent of Time: HIS judgment

48: 1 Furthermore, in that place I saw the fountain of righteousness, which does not become depleted and is surrounded completely by numerous fountains of wisdom.

48:2 All the thirsty ones drink of the water and become filled with wisdom. Then their dwelling places become with the kodesh, righteous, and elect ones.

Rev 1:17. And when I saw him, I fell at his feet like one dead. And he laid his right hand upon me, and said, "Fear not: I am the First and the Last;

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
