
This episode of *Hebrew Voices* is one of the most exciting things I have ever discovered: A Hebrew Manuscript of the Book of Revelation! 



Others suggest the name of the group implies a rigid kind of hierarchy because nicholaitan can be read as "to conquer the people". 


That is quite the laundry list of 10 things they were doing right! Most of which "the Church" is not doing today and what most of us are finding harder and harder to do.

This same laundry list of achievements would be considered by most as a fine example of being "in Covenant' or even a "good Christian". But it is not enough. They were missing a key element. Keep that in the sticky side of your mind.

Today we will take a look at verse 1, and then next time we will take a look at the history of Ephesus to get a feel for what the culture was surrounding the assembly. We will find that in 2023 we have a very similar predicament to contend with.

Then we will take a look more deeply into the rest of the verses and see if we can find out exactly what Yahusha was congratulating them for, so we can learn from that and then what they missed. It is a very dire warning Yahusha gave for missing that vital step. Leaving our first love. "I will come to you quickly, and I will remove your menorah from its place, except you repent".

Ephesus, being a harbor city on the shores of the Aegean Sea, has moved nine kilometers away from the sea by alluvium carried by streams over the last 2,500 years.

On thing that stands out is that there is a particular focus on this area by Yahusha. Not Yahrushalm. He was looking to preserve a remnant from these assemblies to bear the true message of the "Good News". Obviously, the total debacle that is Christianity from these very areas would need a strong opposition in teaching to continue. Notice how he is walking in the midst of them. The Sprint of Truth sent from him and Yahuah was ready and willing to help. It was so dire, Yahusha has to send a warning back that even though they still had John, (Yahuchanon) alive with them, they were on the wrong path. Imagine that if you will. 



The warning is for the humans, but Yahusha is letting them all know, that he knows what is going on. He knows from personal experience how hard this is. But a lot is at stake... for them and us.




